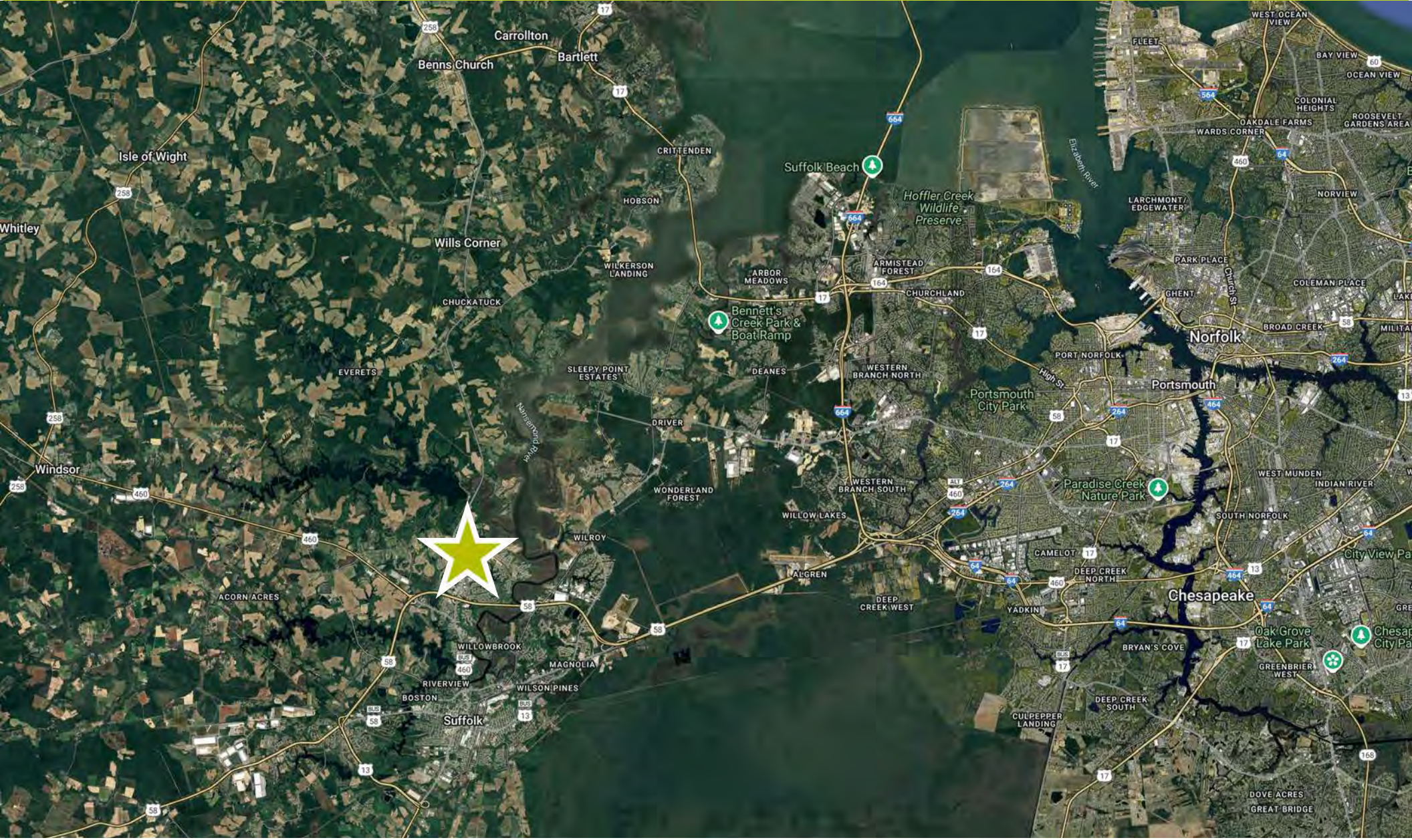

The property is situated on the heavily trafficked Godwin Boulevard with excellent visibility - over 32,704 VPD. This Center is located across the street from a new Publix-anchored center and less than a 1/2 mile from Sentara Obici Hospital.

Godwin Marketplace is centrally located within one (1) mile from Route 58 & Route 460 in Suffolk, in a moderately populated area with over 51,232 people living within a 5-mile radius of the property. It is one of Virginia's fastest-growing cities, projected to exceed 100,000 residents before the end of 2026 and housing is expected to grow 9.20% by 2030.

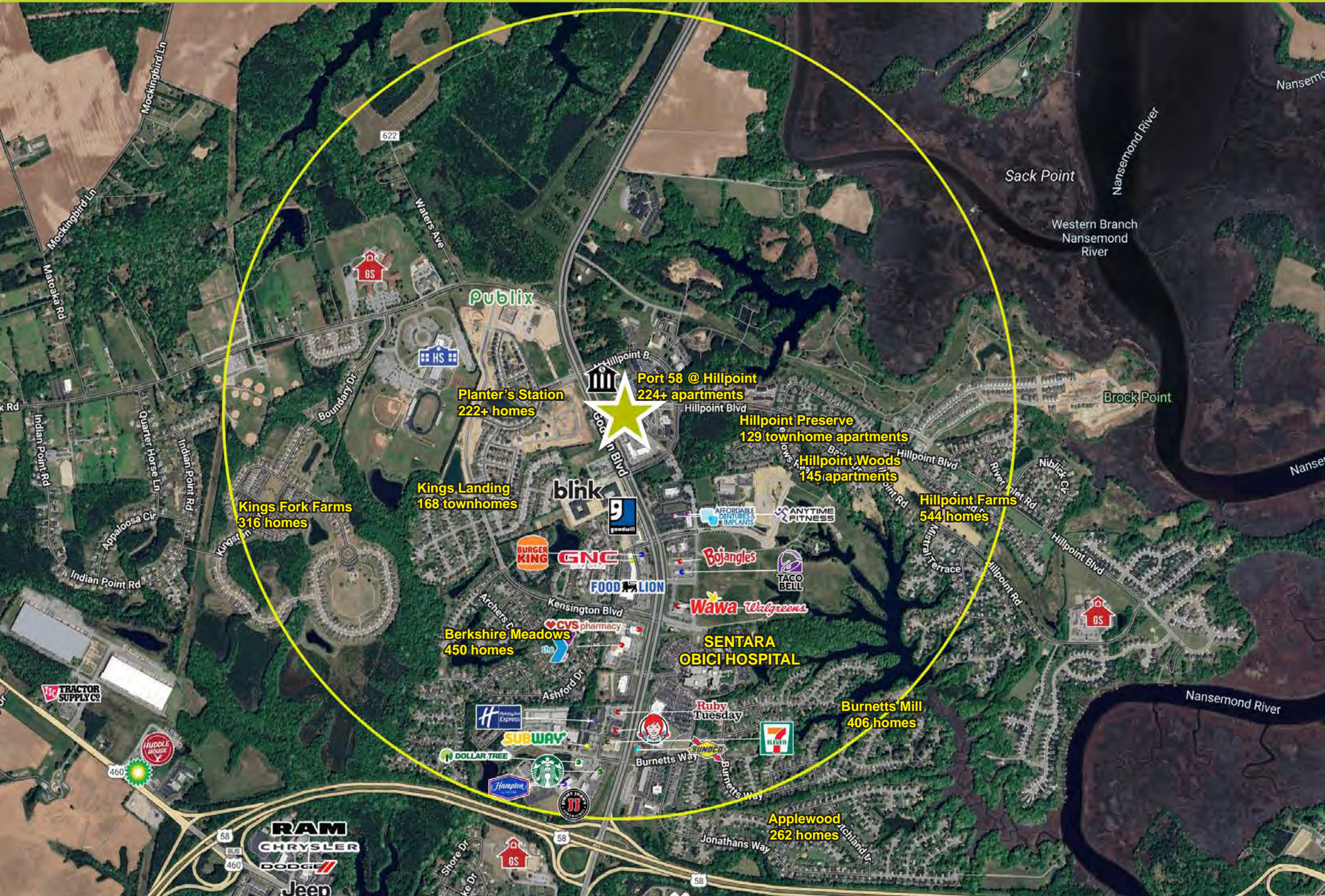
Suffolk's transportation infrastructure includes several major highways, including US 13, 17, 58, 258, and 460, and is served by Interstate 664, part of the Hampton Roads Beltway. The property is located in Virginia's second largest city by land area and the 14th largest in the United States, covering 400-430 square miles.

It has three freight railroads and is being considered for a potential branch line of the Southeast High Speed Rail Corridor. Suffolk Transit provides local bus service, with connections to Hampton Roads Transit. The Monitor-Merrimac Memorial Bridge-Tunnel connects Suffolk to Newport News across the Hampton Roads harbor.

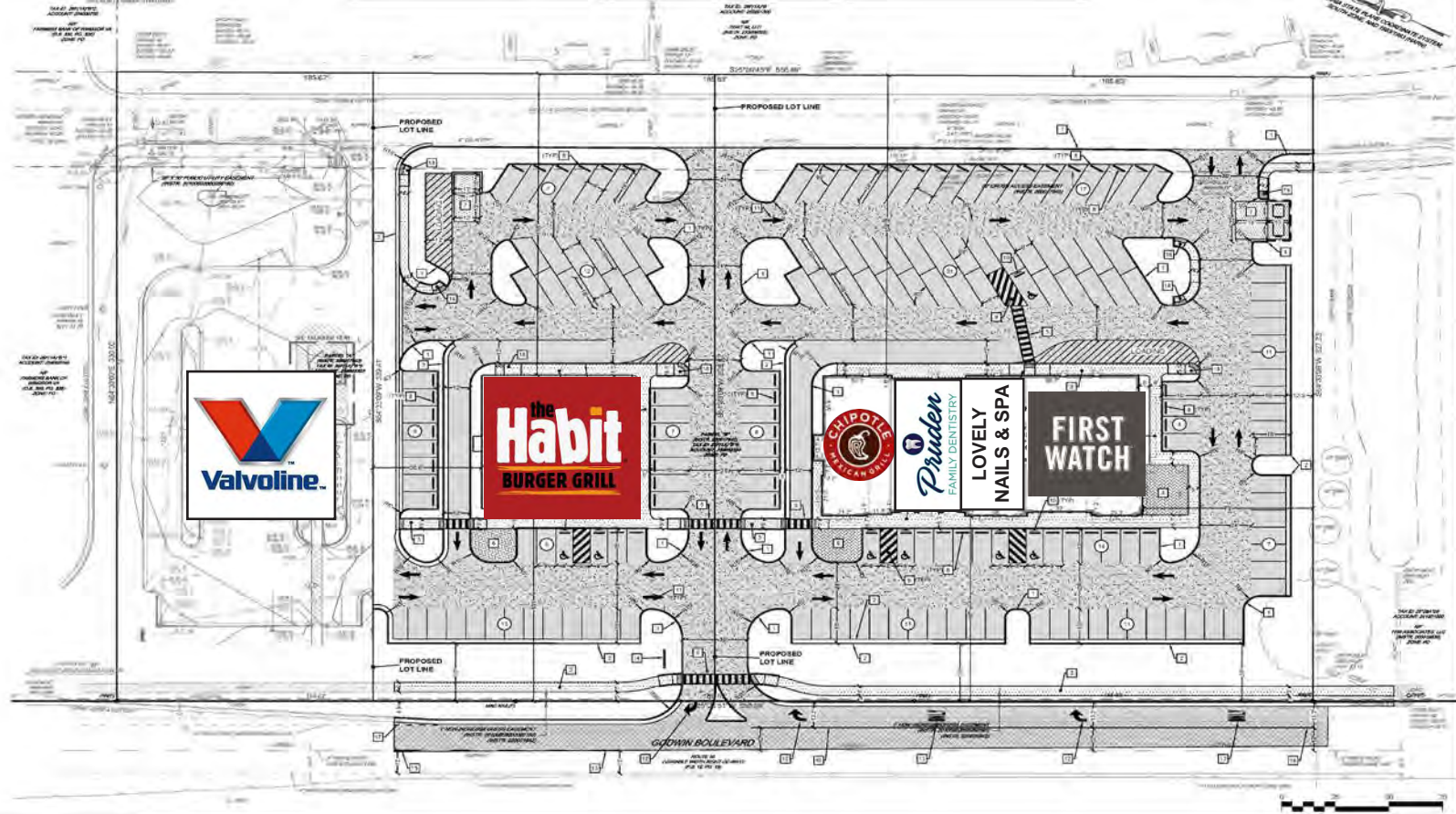

This development provides a unique opportunity for investors to acquire an asset in a rapidly growing area in Suffolk, Virginia. Over 51, 232 people are living within a five mile radius of the property. Average household income within a three mile radius exceeds \$130,634.

In addition to the high average household incomes, the median value of homes are \$330,763 within a one mile radius increasing to \$363,635 within a three mile radius.

Key tenants include Valvoline, The Habit Burger Grill, Chiptole, Pruden Family Dentistry, Queen's Nail Spa by Linh, and First Watch.

As of 2023, it is the second largest oil change service provider in the United States with 10% market share and over 1,650 locations.



Habit Burger Grill is a fast-casual restaurant chain known for its charbroiled burgers and other Californian-inspired fare. Founded in Santa Barbara, California, in 1969, it has grown to over 300 locations across 14 states and internationally. The Habit is recognized for its commitment to quality, made-to-order food, including its signature Charburger cooked over an open flame. Beyond burgers, the menu includes handcrafted sandwiches, fresh salads, and creamy shakes. The Habit Burger Grill was acquired by Yum! Brands in 2020, joining the ranks of Taco Bell, KFC, and Pizza Hut, according to Nation's Restaurant News.



Chipotle Mexican Grill is a fast-casual restaurant chain known for its focus on fresh, high-quality ingredients and customizable burritos, bowls, tacos, and salads. Founded in 1993 by Steve Eells, it emphasizes "Food with Integrity," sourcing ingredients responsibly and using classic cooking techniques. Chipotle has grown from a single Denver restaurant to a global chain with over 3,700 locations, according to Statista, and is a leader in the fast-casual sector.

Economy and Industry

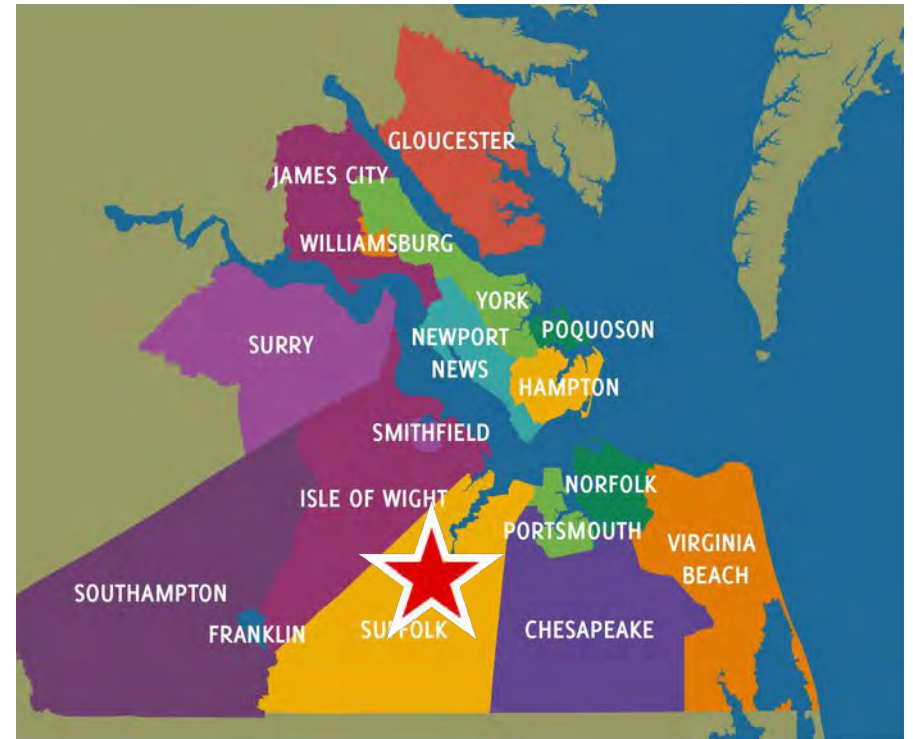
Suffolk has a long history tied to agriculture, particularly tobacco and later peanuts. In 1912, Amedeo Obici founded the Planters Nut and Chocolate Company in Suffolk, leading to the city being known as the "Peanut Capital of the World". Today, Suffolk remains a major peanut processing center and transportation hub. The city's economy is diverse, encompassing industries like food and beverage processing, warehousing, distribution, and professional office space, benefiting from its proximity to The Port of Virginia. It also has a significant presence in the defense and technology sectors, with companies like Lockheed Martin and Raytheon, and has been dubbed "Pentagon South" due to the presence of various Navy commands and the Joint Staff Joint and Coalition Warfighting Center.

Demographics

In 2020, Suffolk's population was 94,324. It is one of Virginia's fastest-growing cities, projected to exceed 100,000 residents before 2025. As of 2023, the racial composition includes 46.5% White (non-Hispanic), 41.5% Black or African American (non-Hispanic), with smaller percentages for other racial and ethnic groups. The median household income in 2023 was \$90,089, and the poverty rate was 9.87%.

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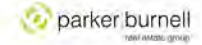
