

166 Center St. Cape Canaveral, FL

166 Center St. was originally built in 1967 to support the NASA Space Center industry.

The building has five stairways (one in each corner of the building) with the main stairway in the lobby of the building leading to the overlooking balcony on the second floor. A primary elevator in the lobby services people between the floors, while a freight elevator in the rear of the building allows for moving furniture, equipment and other business related needs.

Common areas of the building have been upgraded with LED lighting, new carpet, new baseboards, new paint, and the main Lobby wall has been accented with stone work for a modern look and feel.

At the rear (north side) of the building, there is a dock high loading platform with an accompanying ramp. This loading dock/ramp allows for both wheel off deliveries as well as fork lift required deliveries. The rear building access has a roll up door at the loading dock as well as a double-door entry immediately adjacent to the freight elevator.

This 2.23-acre parcel is just 300 feet from a traffic light controlled corner of Atlantic Ave., which is the main road in Cape Canaveral & Cocoa Beach.
