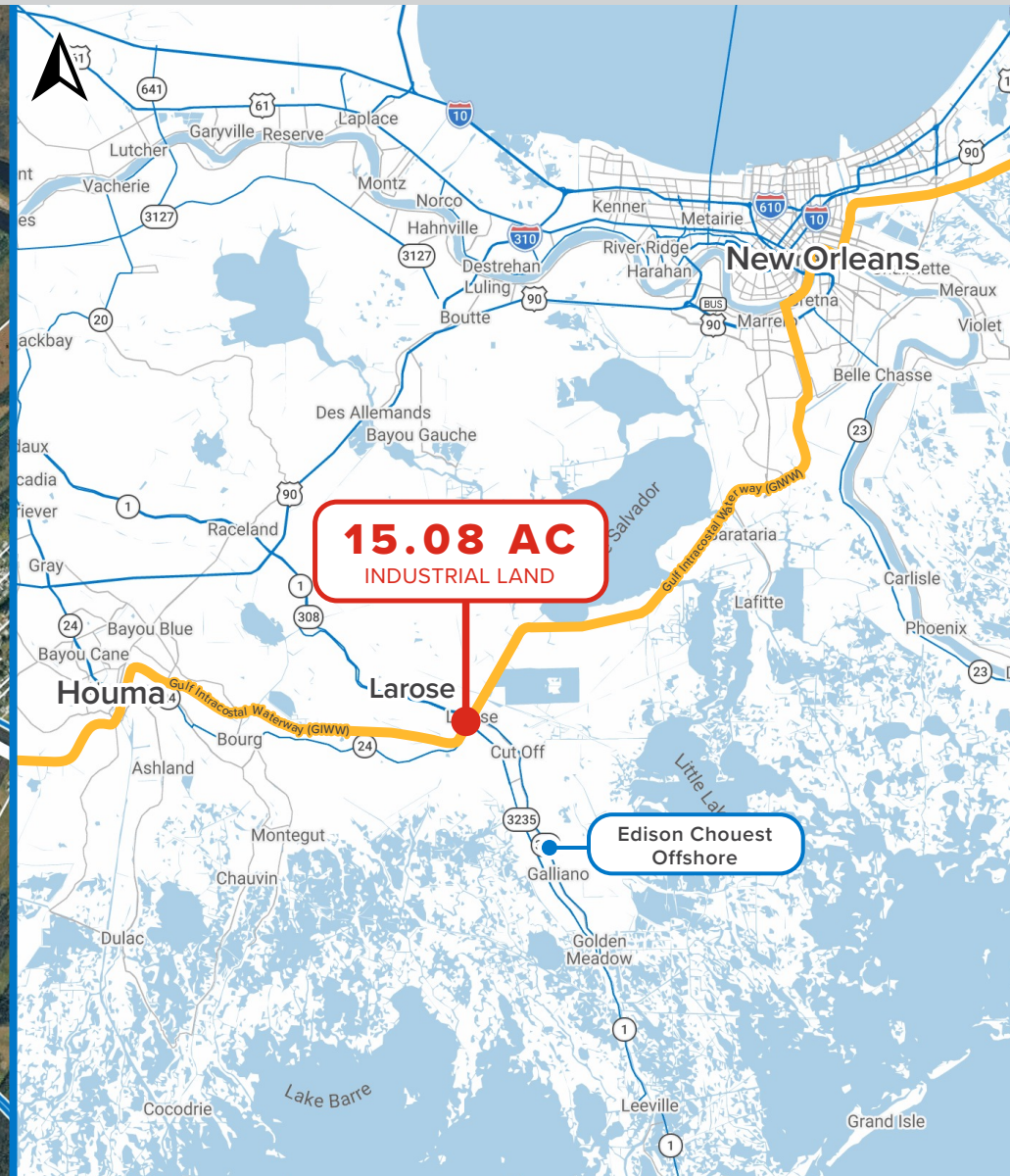
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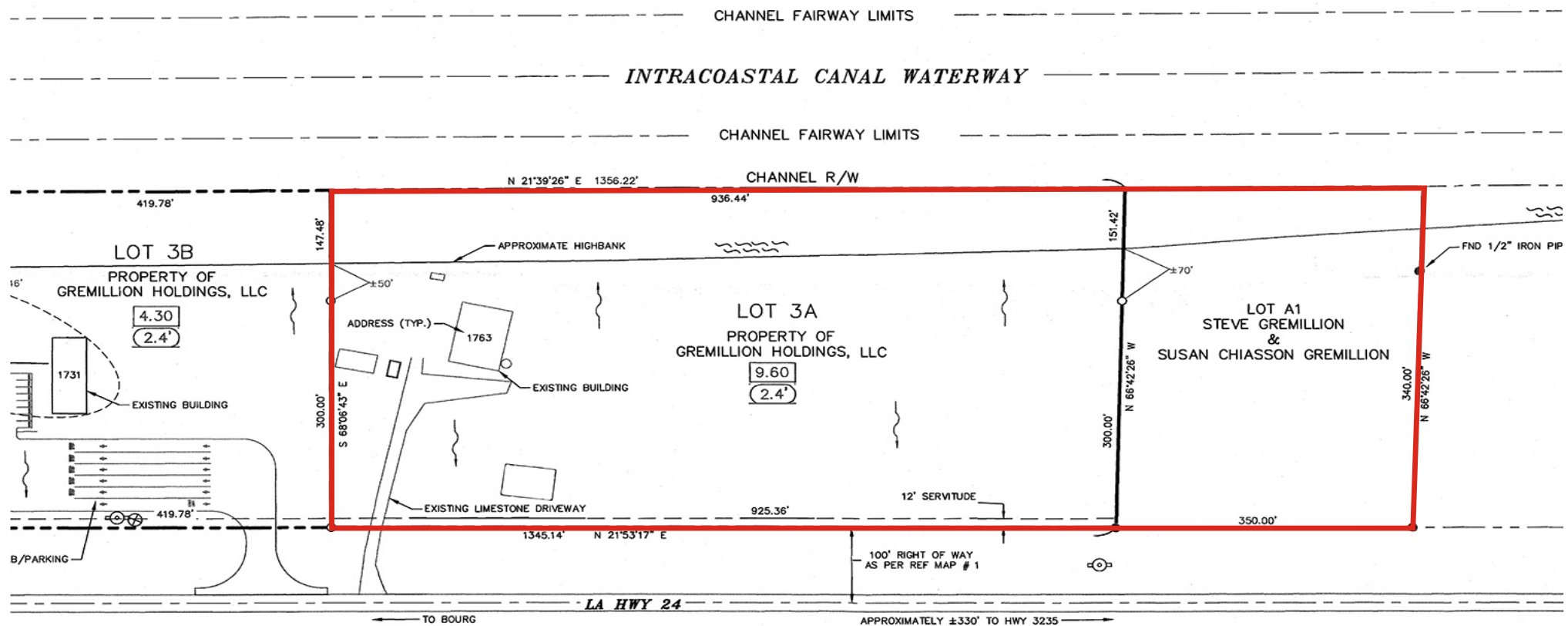

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GULF INTRACOSTAL WATERWAY

Our waterfront industrial land sits directly on the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway (GIWW), a federally maintained, 1,100+ mile shipping channel across Louisiana that runs from Texas to the Florida Panhandle with a maintained depth of roughly 12 feet. The GIWW is engineered specifically to keep barge and vessel traffic moving safely between Gulf Coast ports. As one of the busiest waterway corridors in the country, the GIWW links this location westward toward Lake Charles, and the Texas industrial coast, and eastward toward New Orleans and the Mississippi River system.

At Larose, the GIWW intersects Bayou Lafourche, which flows south directly to Port Fourchon — Louisiana's southernmost deepwater port and home base to more than 90% of Gulf of Mexico deepwater oil and gas production — making this stretch of waterway a critical corridor for vessels, equipment, and crews supporting the offshore energy industry. Over 400 large supply vessels move through Port Fourchon's channels every day. Highway 1 and Highway 308 parallel the bayou through Larose, connecting the waterway corridor to Port Fourchon, Houma, and the interstate system for seamless water-to-road logistics. With 1,314 feet of bulkheaded frontage directly on this heavily trafficked channel, the property offers a rare opportunity to establish permanent dock access along one of the Gulf Coast's most strategically important shipping routes.
