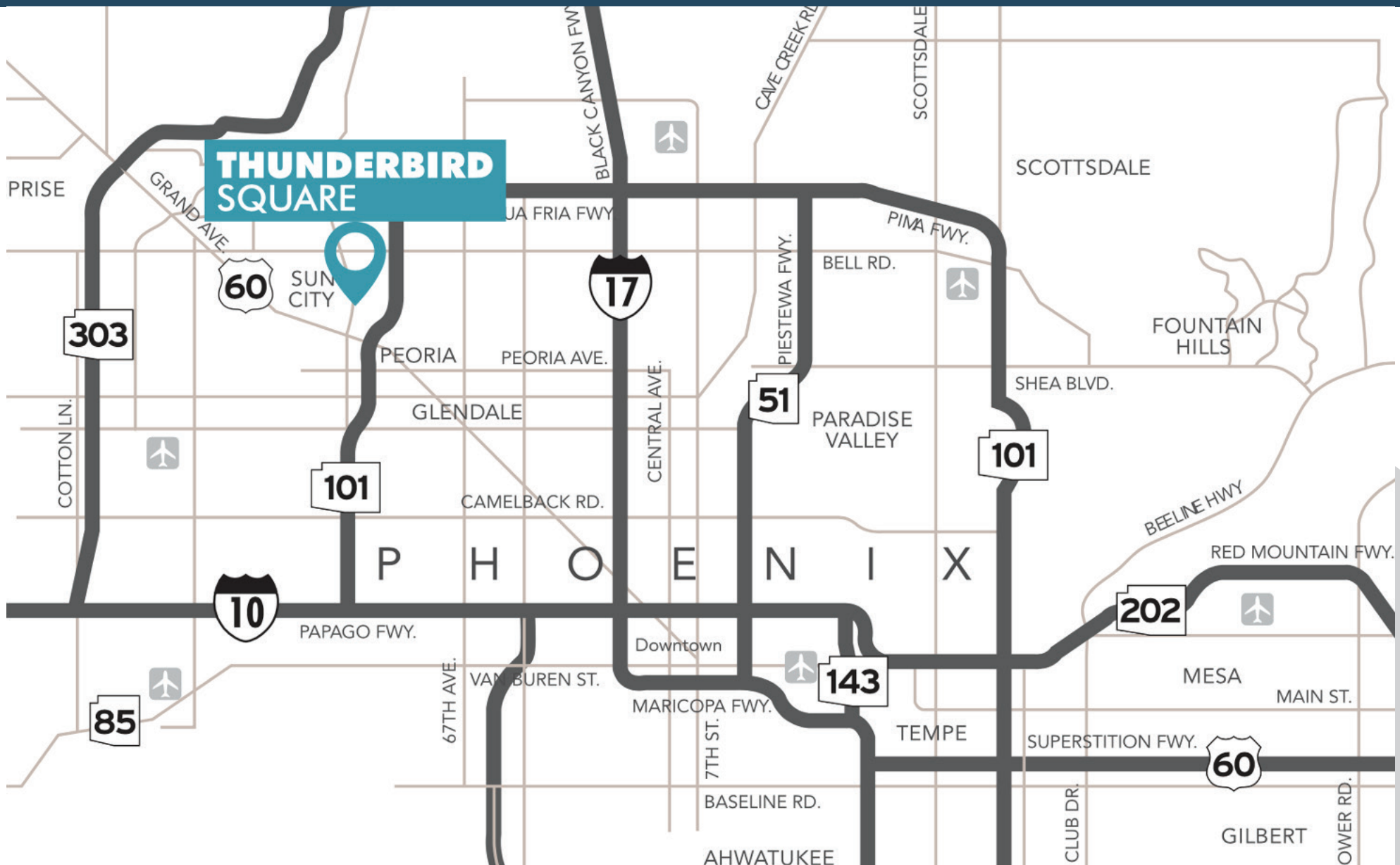

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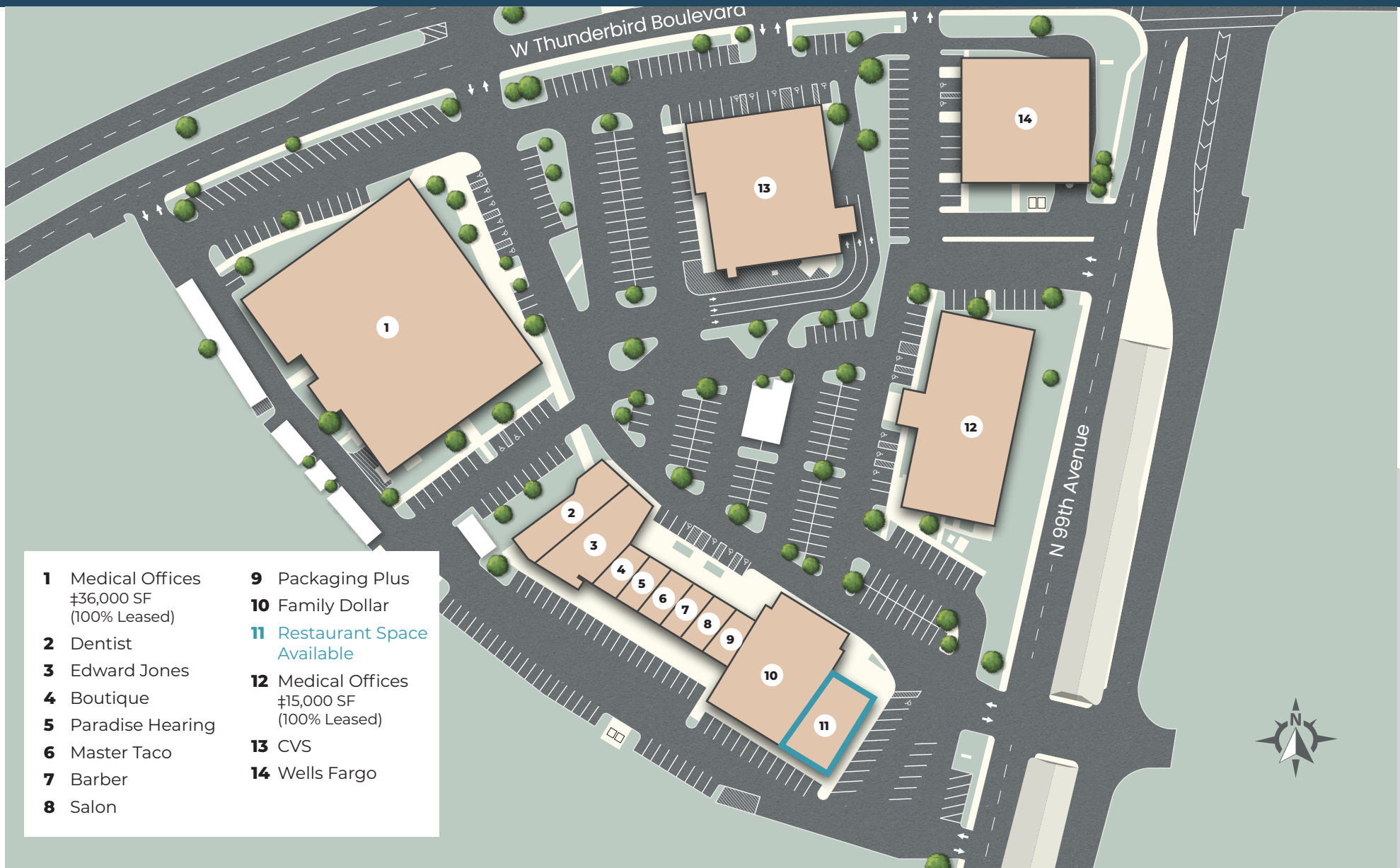

After more than 50 years, Sun City remains a desirable self-contained community where residents can meet all their needs without having to leave its boundaries. Above all, Sun City is renowned for its healthcare amenities, incredible home values, low property taxes and minimal association fees.

The Baby Boomer generation, who began entering the retirement age over the last decade, is set to redefine traditional retirement, and Sun City is positioned perfectly to draw these Baby Boomers in with the vast amount of amenities conveniently located within the community. Despite the construction of more newly established active adult communities in Arizona, Sun City Arizona remains a popular retirement destination.

Preferred by buyers who want low property taxes, reasonably priced homes and mature landscaping in a good location near extensive shopping and close to the highway. These attributes, along with newly remodeled homes and recreation centers, make this 55+ community a value that cannot be ignored.
