The Peekskill Business Improvement District ("BID") works to promote the growth and development of downtown Peekskill as an attractive place to live and do business through business recruitment and retention, capital improvements, marketing and promotions, beautification and clean efforts, event creation and support, and advocacy for small businesses.

Founded in 1996 as a non-profit corporation, the Peekskill BID encompasses downtown's Central Commercial District — a 25 block area home to restaurants, coffee shops, specialty retailers, artists, live/work studios, and professional services like accountants, dentists, and attorneys. The BID also manages the Peekskill Farmers Market and Peekskill Flea Markets as well as co-sponsors with the City of the

Annual Holiday Tree Lighting Ceremony.

911 South Street provides live-work housing opportunities for certified artists ("Artist Lofts") designated by the Peekskill Arts Council.
