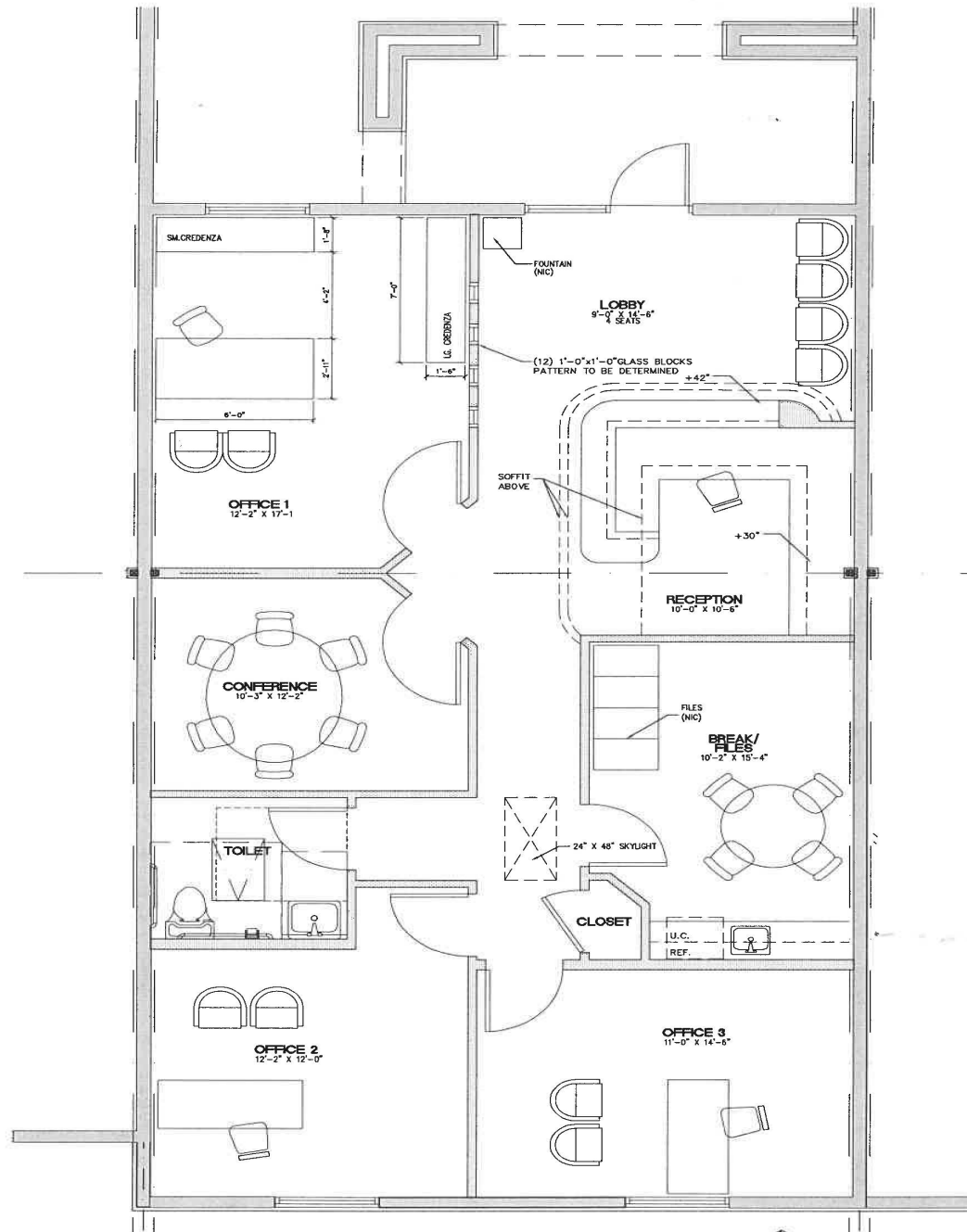

ABOUT TUCSON

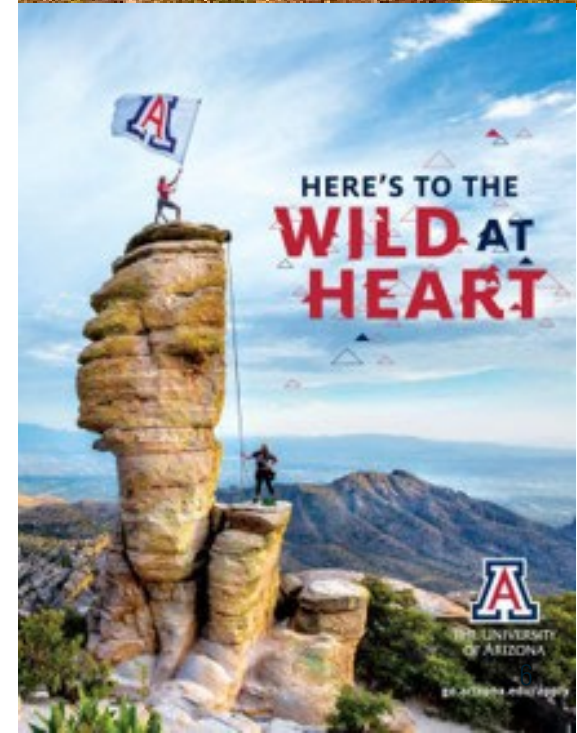


- The Tucson MSA serves a market of 45 million people within a 500-mile radius. It lies within 415 miles of Southern California population centers and within 64 miles of the Mexican Border, Arizona's largest trade partner.
- Tucson and Southern Arizona has evolved into a hot spot for technology and innovation. Home to the University of Arizona, there's a reason why nationally-recognized companies such as Amazon, Caterpillar, Raytheon, a division of RTX, Roche Tissue Diagnostics, Bombardier, GEICO, HomeGoods, Hexagon Mining, Modular Mining, and other many other powerhouses have set their sites on Tucson and Southern Arizona. The combination of Aerospace & Defense, the Optics Industry and Renewable Energy sectors have made Tucson and Southern Arizona a bright star with a bright future. The region is also home to Davis Monthan AFB and Ft. Huachuca. The Tucson International Airport recently underwent a critical renovation including an additional runway and is one of the fastest growing cargo airports.
- Southern Arizona and Tucson, with its rich diverse deserts, outdoor activities, restaurants, exemplifies the whole package. In 2015, Tucson became the first UNESCO City of Gastronomy designed in the United States.
