Location

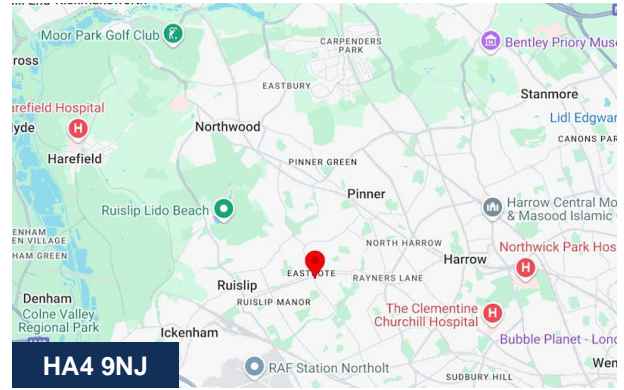
