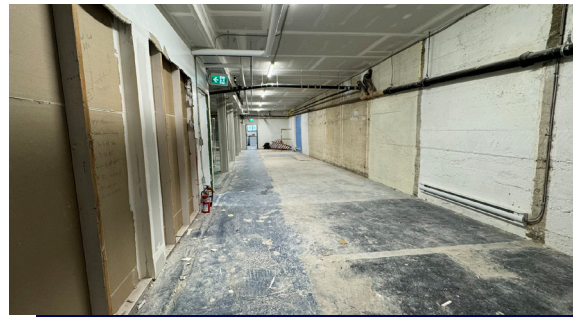

# Building History

1408-1410 Broad Street, designed by architect William Ridgeway Wilson, is of value to Victoria's historic Old Town District because of the integrity of its 1910 building envelope. Although its façade has been considerably altered from its original state, this small-scale Edwardian-era building's value lies in its intact form, which extends the continuity of the heritage character of the commercial streetscape to the northern end of Broad Street.

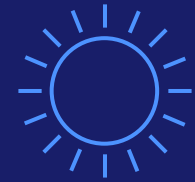

The main floor was home to the Plimley Auto Company, one of Victoria's first automobile businesses, who used the space as a showroom. The shop was owned by Thomas John Plimley, who sold the first car in the city, a tiller-steered Oldsmobile, nine years prior to opening his showroom in 1901.

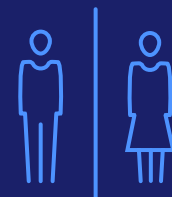
