THE HISTORY OF 480 GREEN

Built in the 1907 the building that would become 480 Green, was part of The New Tivoli Restaurant. It was the events hall, theatre, and bocce ball court. A few years later the newly built Coit Tower would cast its shadow over the building and the block. Over the years, the events hall morphed into concert hall, hosting the Ramons, Robert Palmer, and many other greats from the 60's and 70s. In the 80s it was rebuilt into offices by the famous architectural firm Holt, Hinshaw, and Jones.

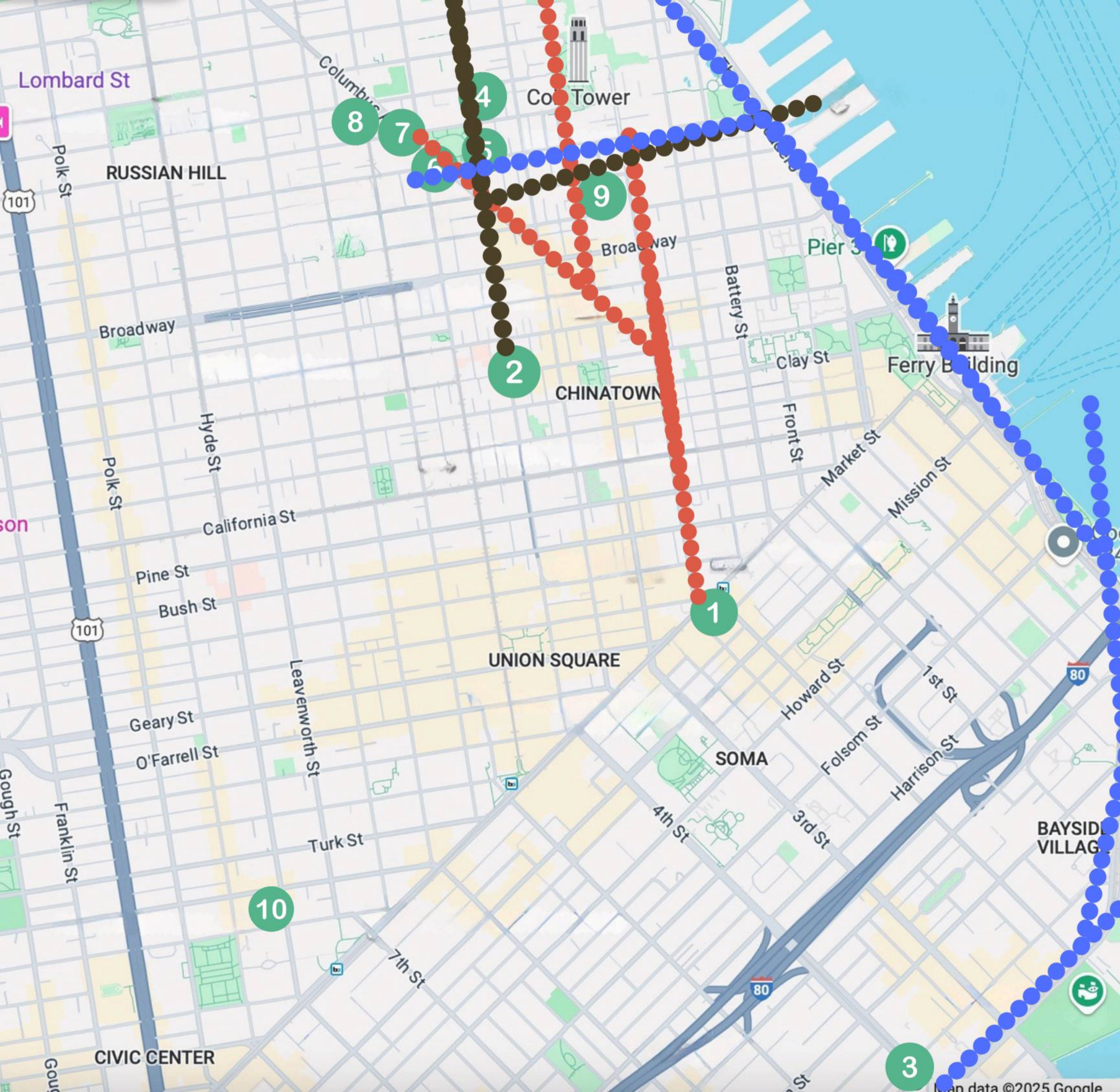

Nestled between buildings, away from street noise, on a mixed-use block, makes 480 Green a quiet, productive, workspace.

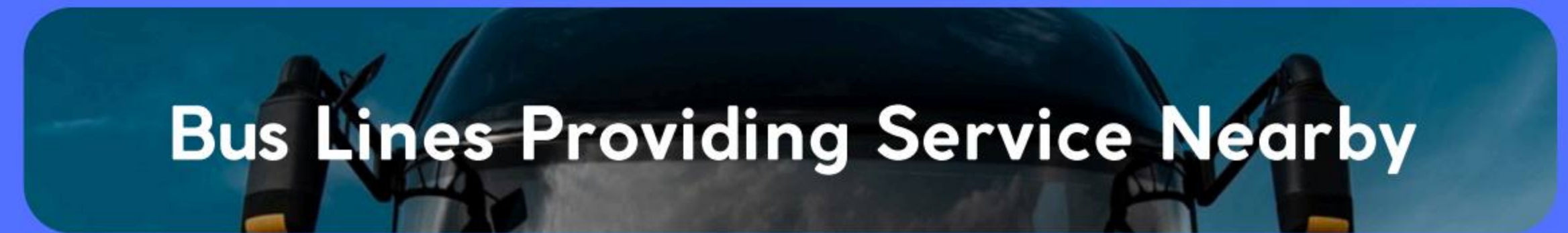

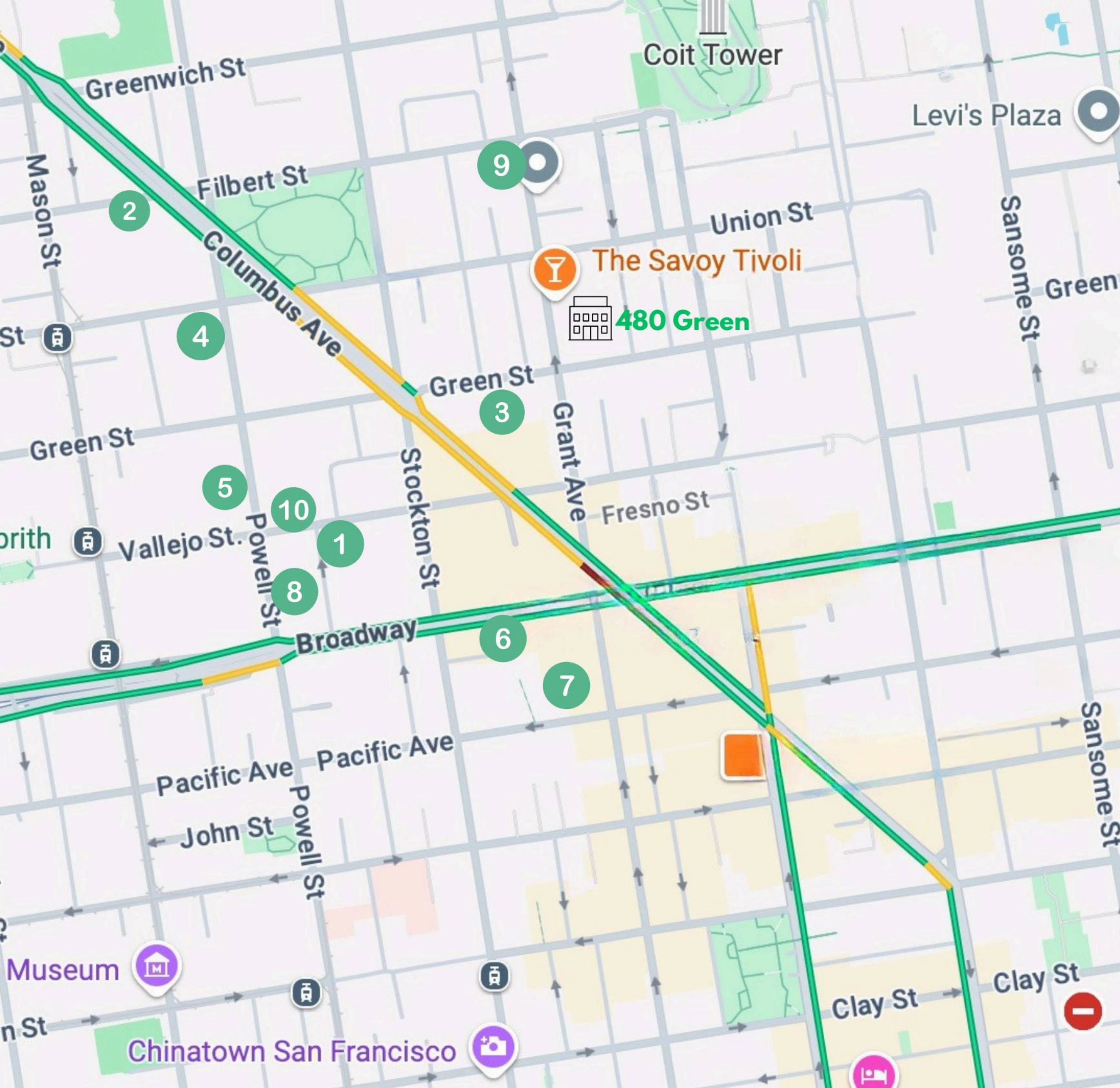

- 3 20 minute bike ride – CalTrain



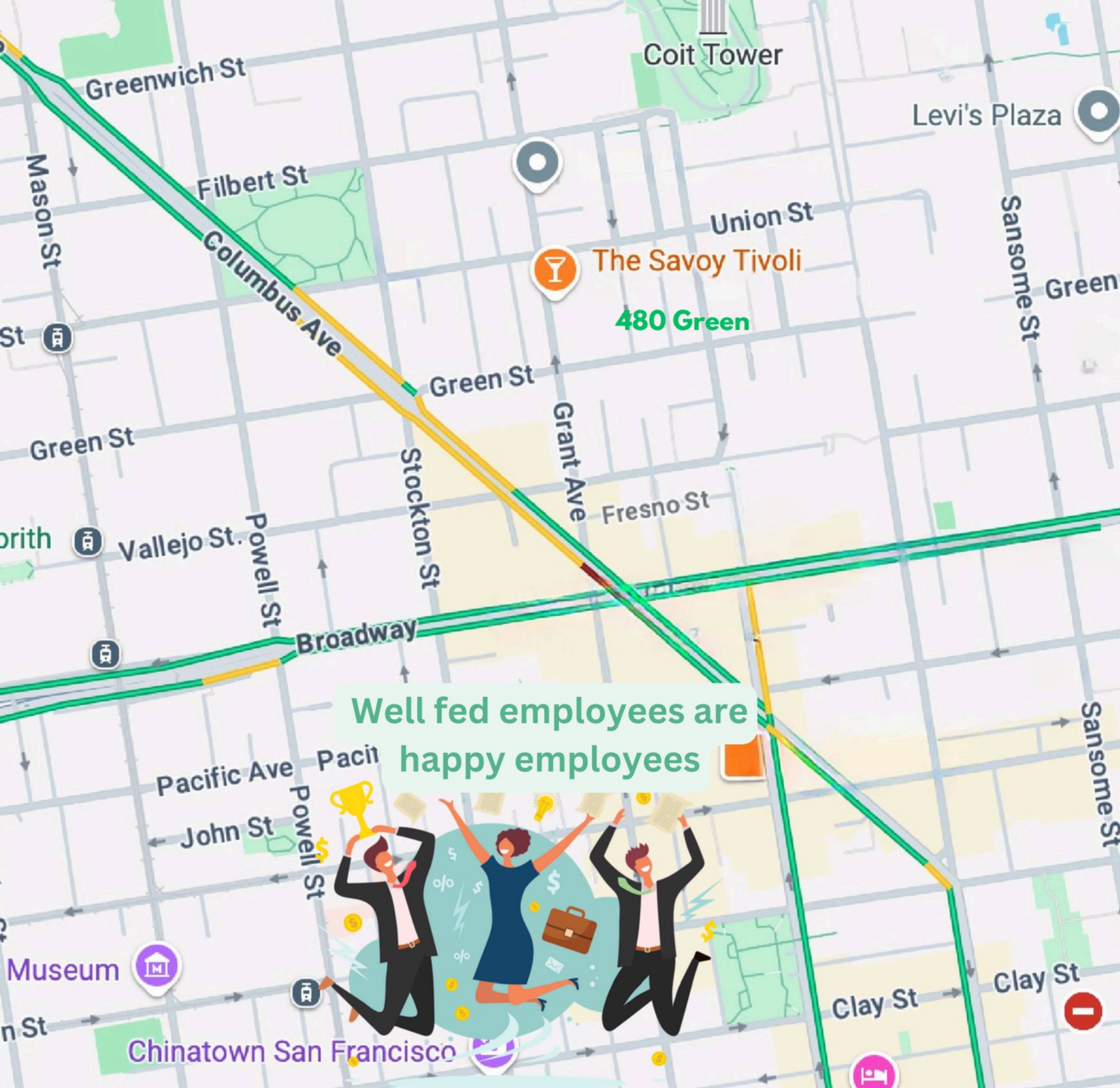

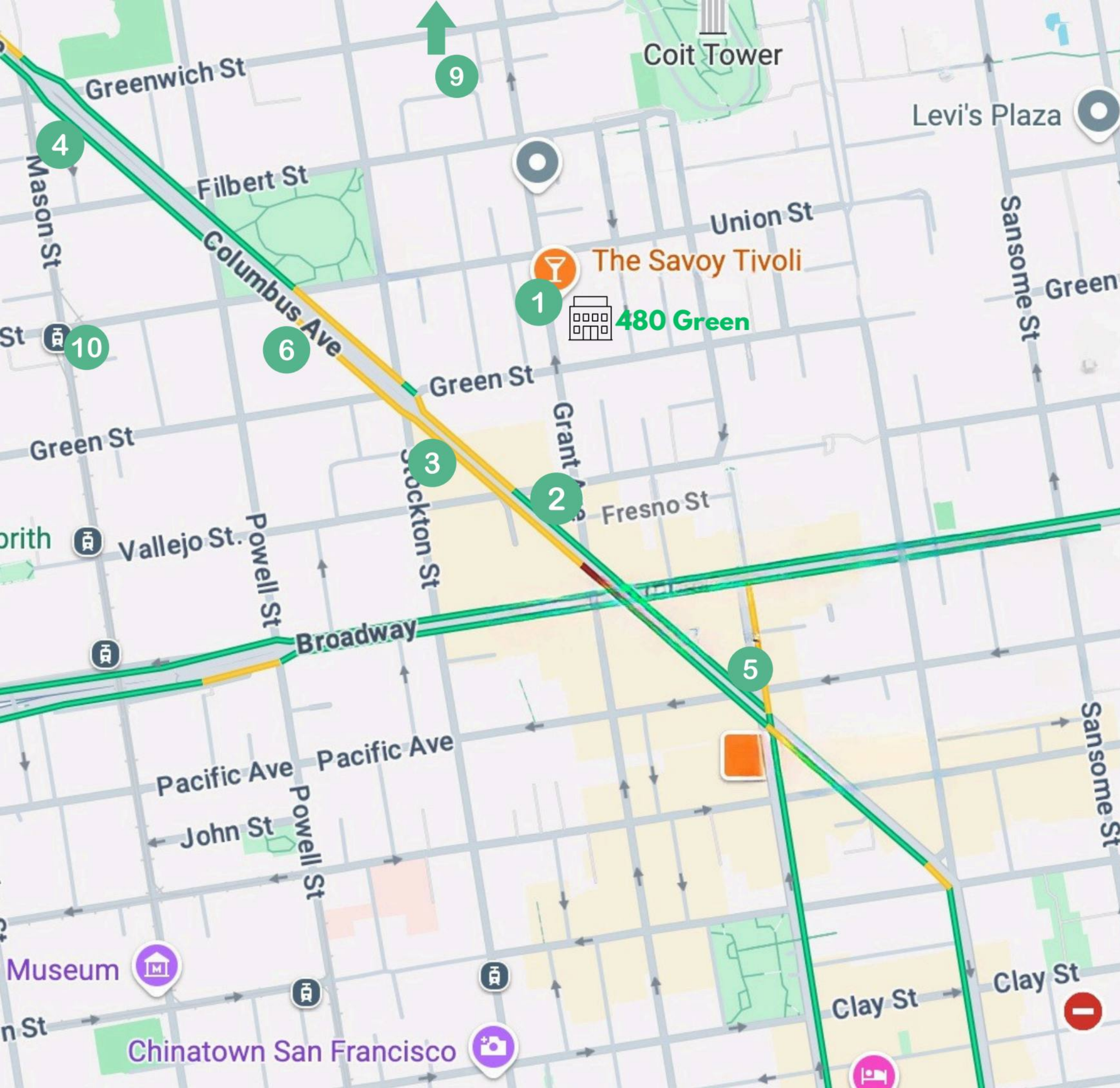

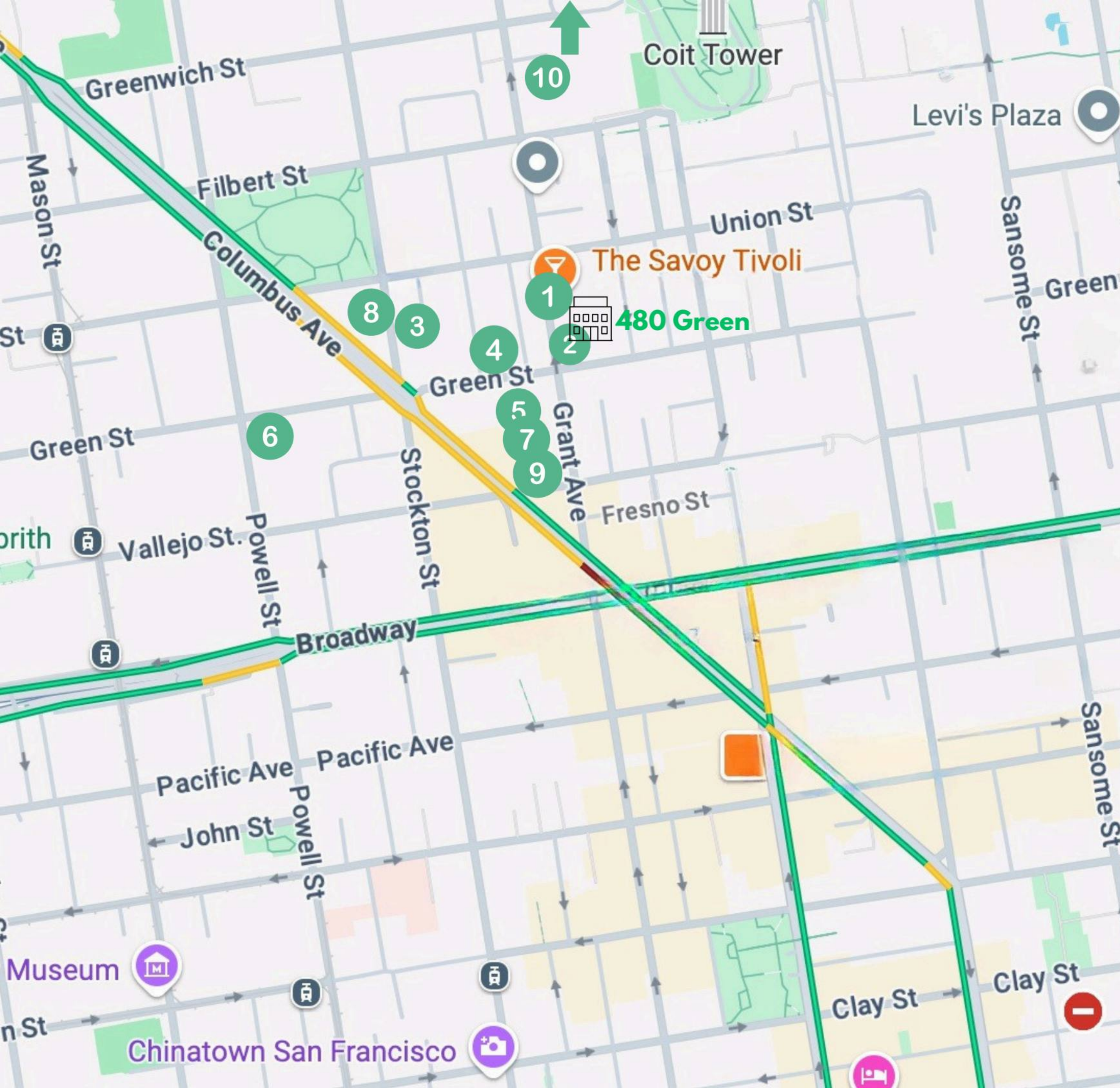
