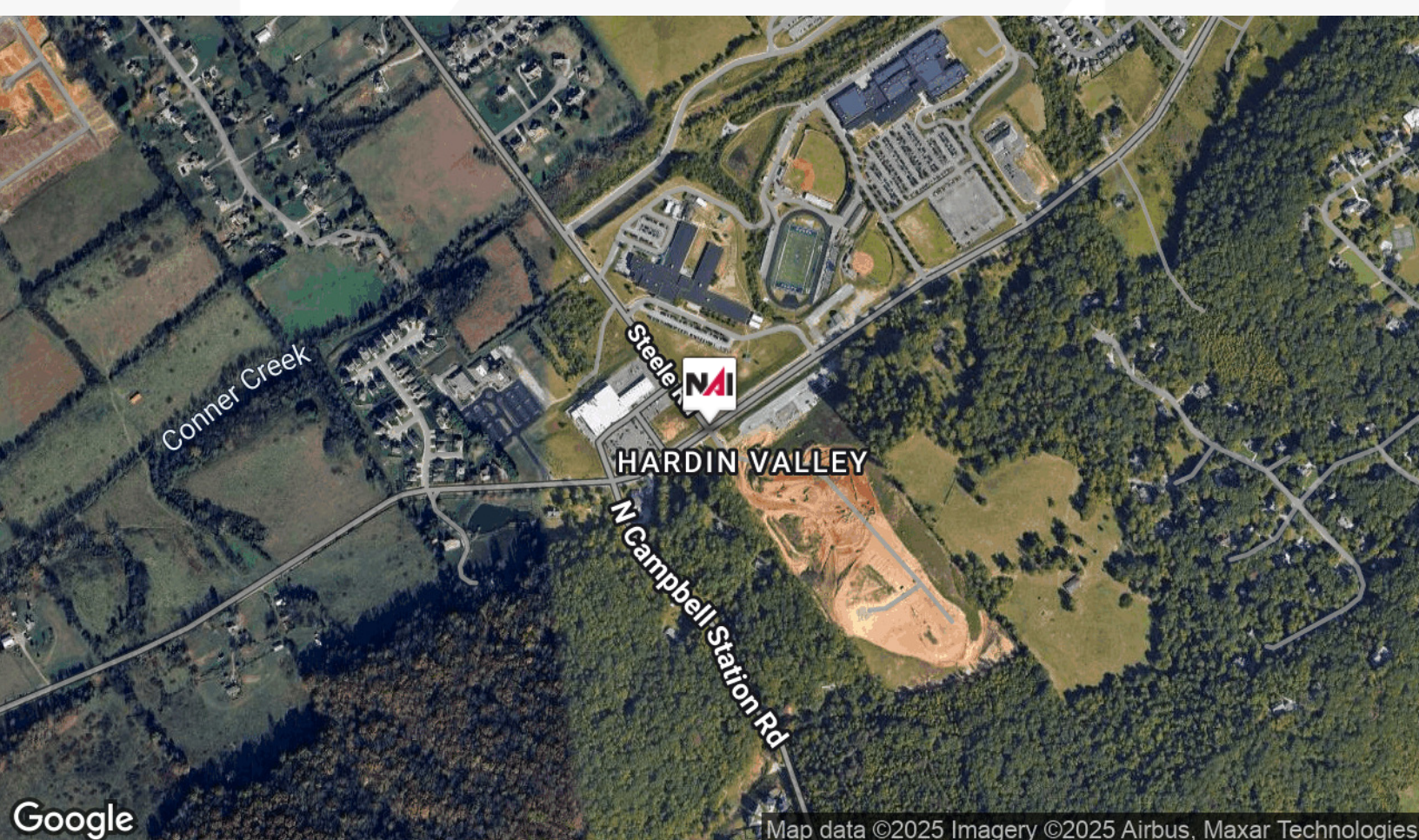
Hardin Valley

Hardin Valley is a rural neighborhood located on the west side of Knoxville, nestled between Farragut (to the south) and Oak Ridge (to the north). Years ago, Hardin Valley was little more than acres of beautiful farmland and home to Pellissippi Community College, but in recent years, this area of town has been undergoing extensive development. Suburban neighborhoods began cropping up in the 1990s along with apartment complexes located close to the community college. Retail development has been expanding, and property values are skyrocketing. While there are many long-time residents who are open activists against all of this expansion, there is little doubt that Hardin Valley will look very different in the next five to ten years, possibly becoming a new hotspot for shopping and recreation much like Farragut. While Hardin Valley still boasts a small-town feel (you will need to travel elsewhere to visit the post office or go to a Walmart), it has become home to many new restaurants, and it honestly has all of the amenities one might need. As of now, it is less expensive to live in Hardin Valley than it is to live in Farragut, but it is still close enough to Farragut (a 15-minute drive) that you won't feel like you're living "out in the boonies."

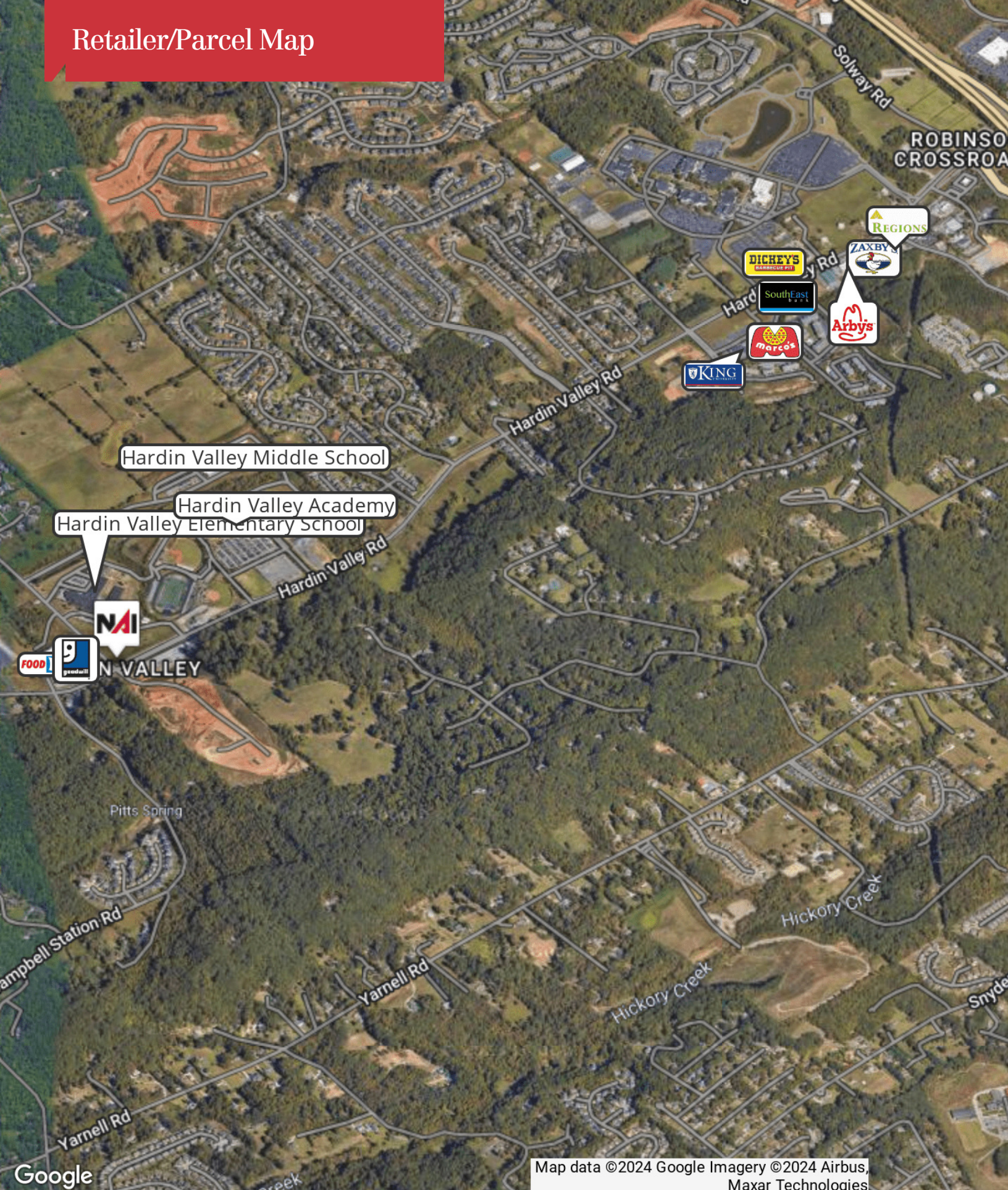
Hardin Valley is home to both popular chain restaurants and small businesses that you won't find anywhere else.

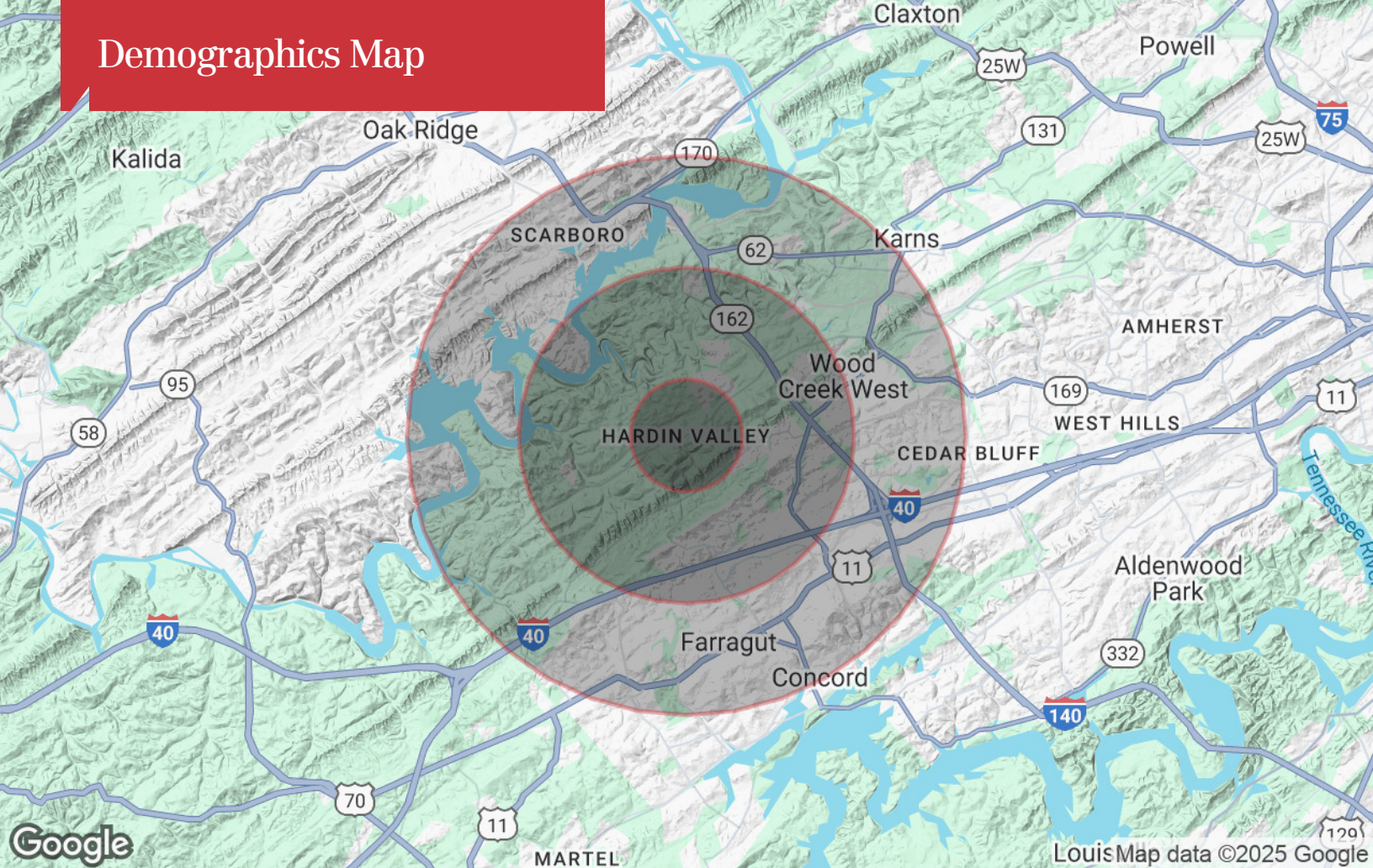


Retailer/Parcel Map
