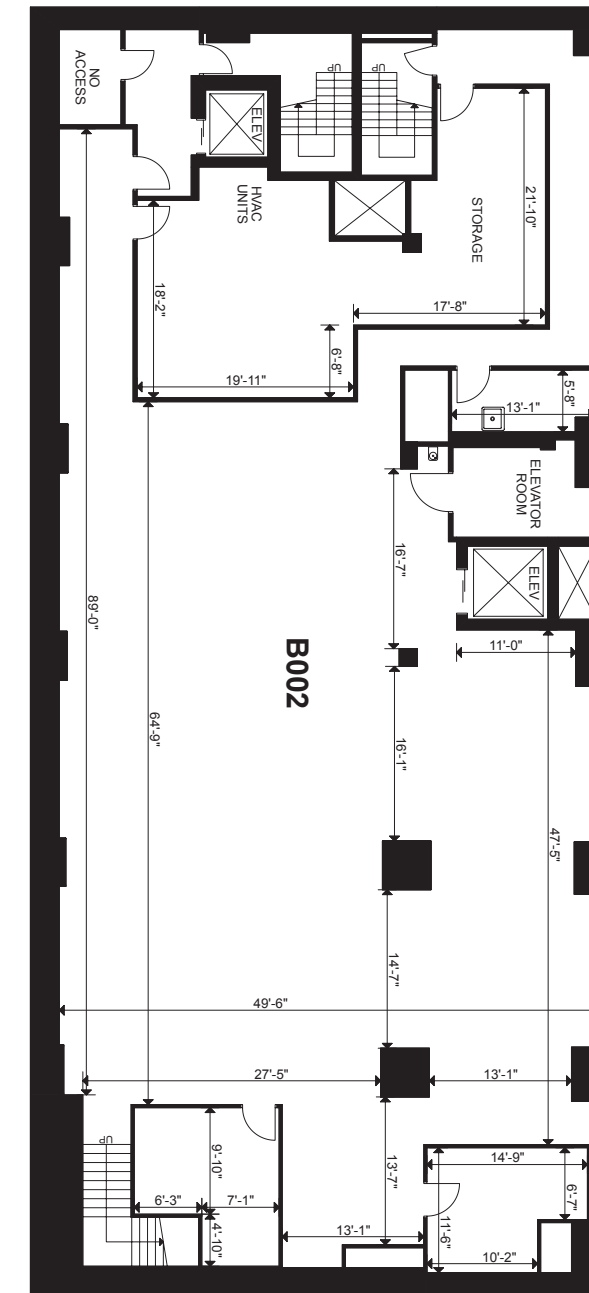

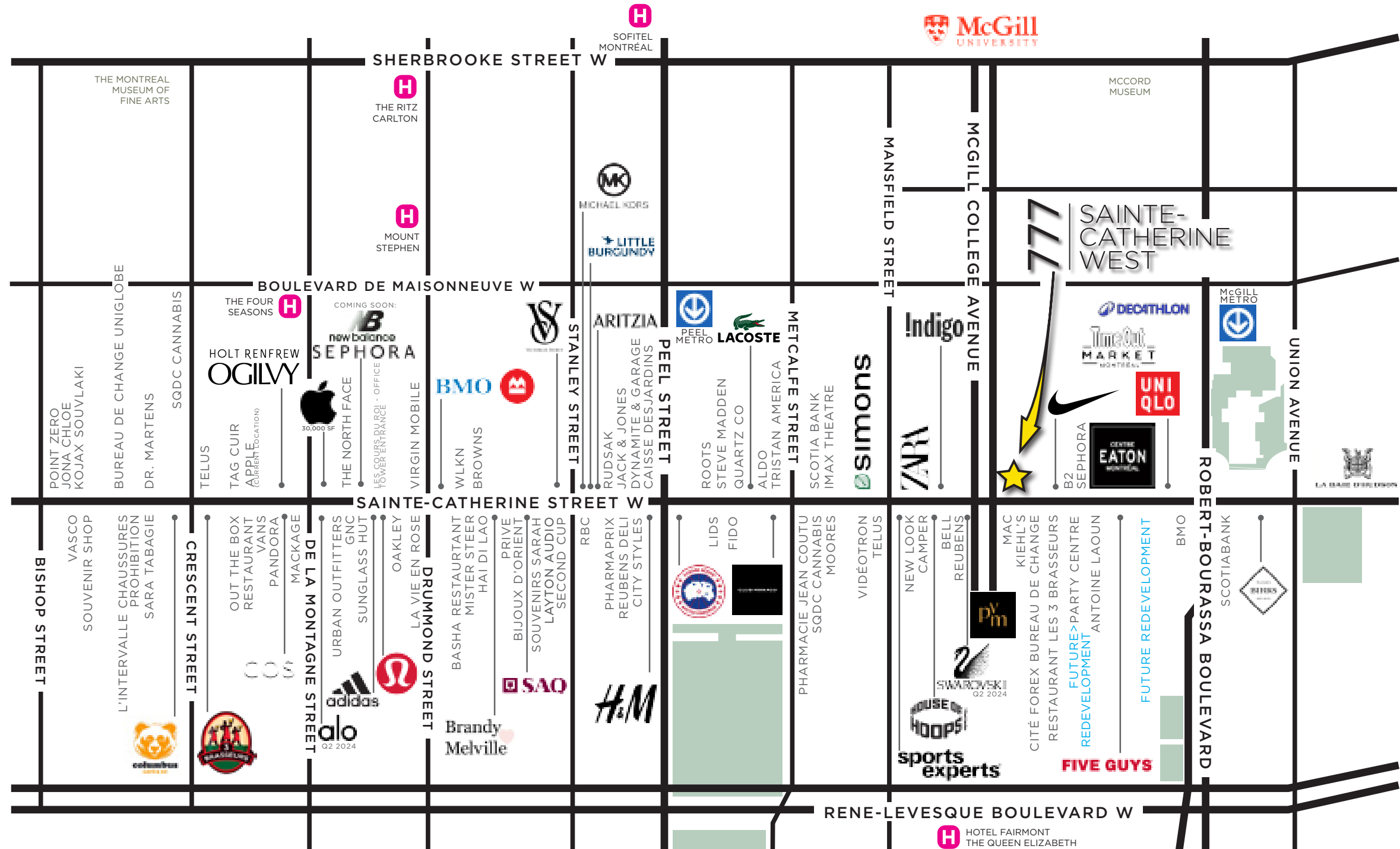

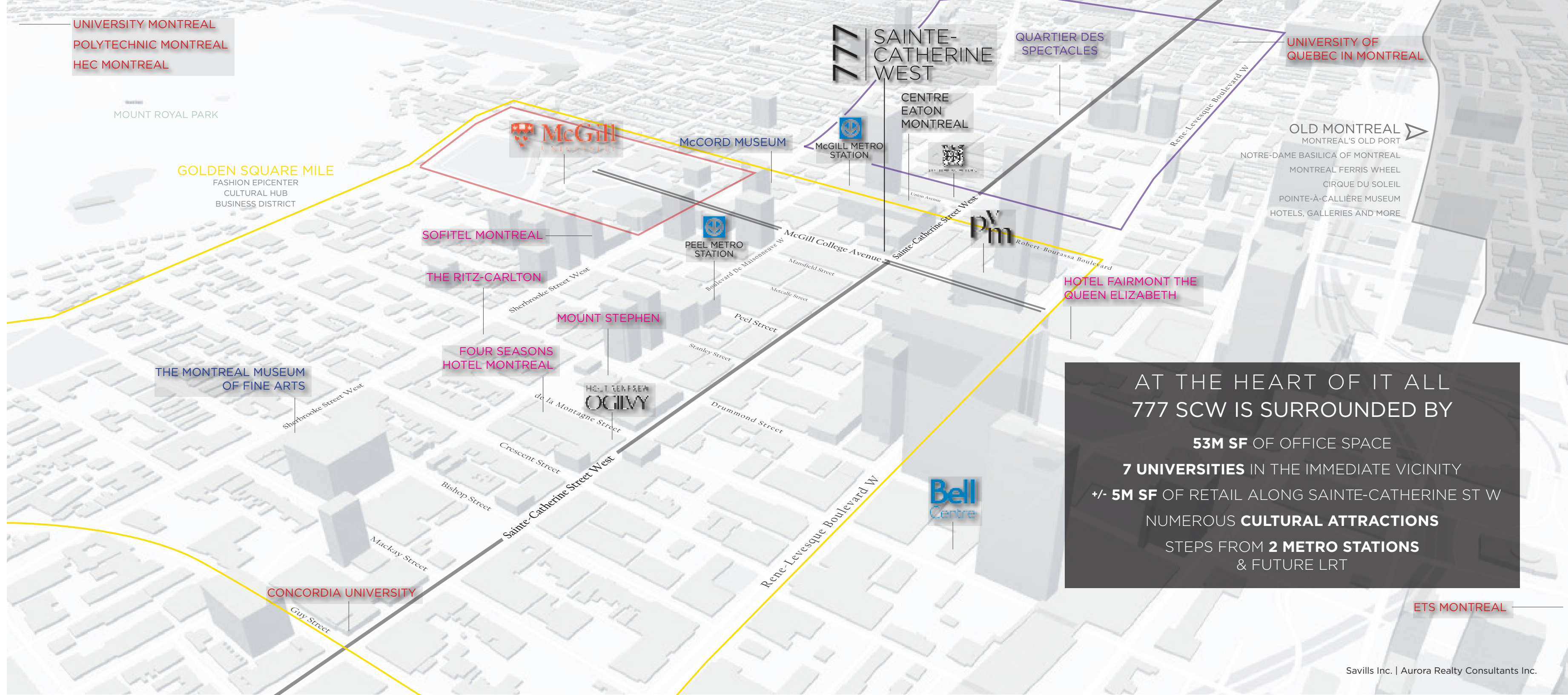

SAINTE-CATHERINE STREET WEST

SAINTE-CATHERINE STREET WEST IS UNDERGOING A MAJOR MAKEOVER AIMED AT OFFERING MONTREALERS AND VISITORS ALIKE, A WELCOMING PUBLIC SPACE AND AN ALL-NEW EXPERIENCE IN DOWNTOWN MONTREAL. THIS MAJOR THOROUGHFARE WILL CONNECT THE DIFFERENT PUBLIC PLACES AROUND IT, INCLUDING THE PLACE DES FESTIVALS, THE SQUARE IN FRONT OF ST. JAMES UNITED CHURCH, SQUARE PHILLIPS, AND MCGILL COLLEGE AVENUE.

THE ICONIC COMMERCIAL STRIP WILL PLACE PEDESTRIANS AT THE HEART OF THE PUBLIC SPACE. THE STREET WILL OFFER A SINGLE TRAFFIC LANE, BORDERED BY BROADER SIDEWALKS AND BE RE-GREENED WITH THE ADDITION OF NUMEROUS TREES, AND EXISTING GREEN SPACES WILL BE CONSOLIDATED TO INCREASE PLANT COVER.

THE REVITALIZATION PROJECT WILL TAKE PART IN 3 PHASES:

- PHASE 1: MANSFIELD TO DE BLEURY
- PHASE 2: ATWATER TO MANSFIELD
- PHASE 3: MCGILL FROM SHERBROOKE TO CATHCART

MCGILL COLLEGE AVENUE

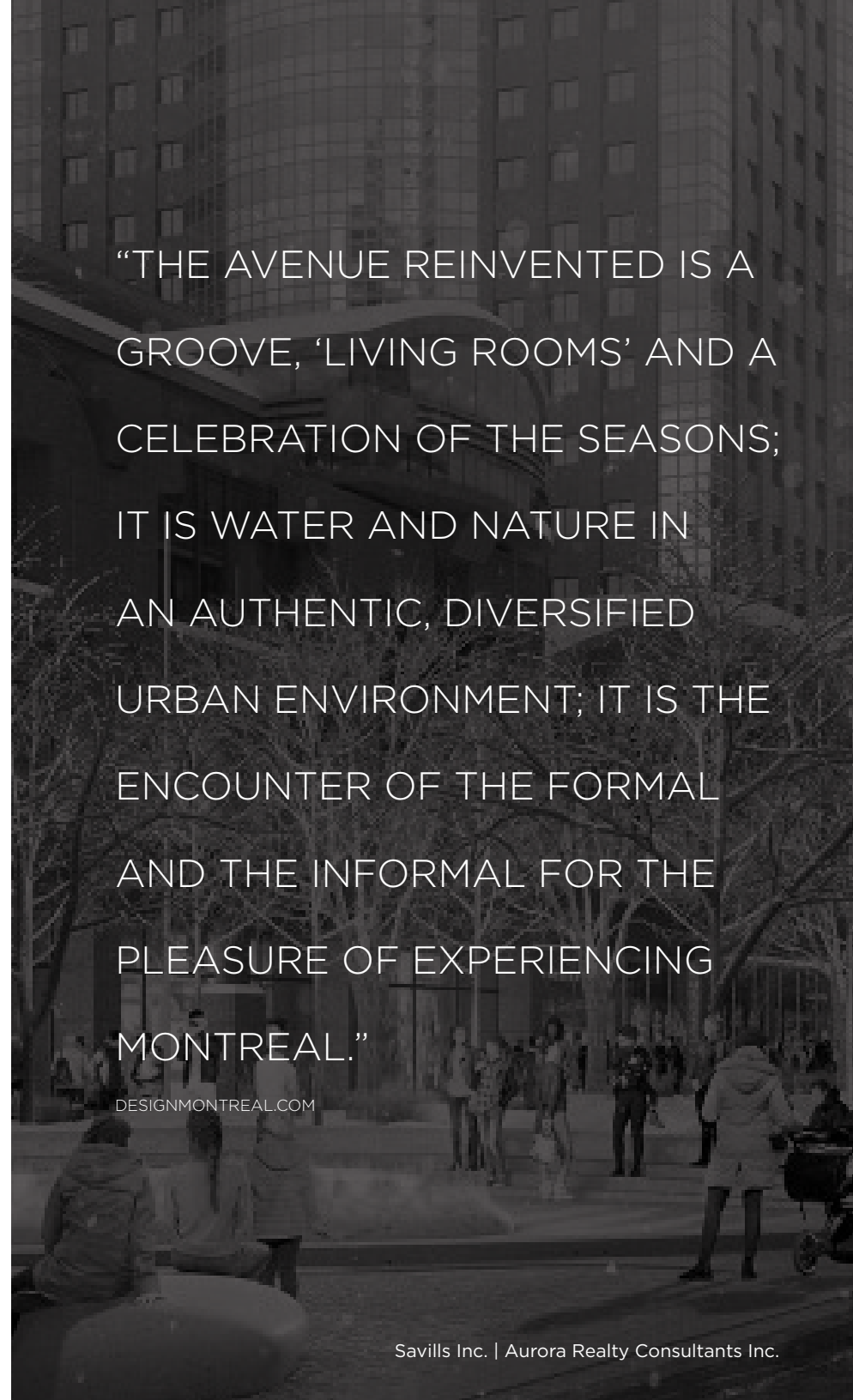
THE AVENUE WILL BE TRANSFORMED INTO AN IMPOSING PEDESTRIAN PUBLIC SQUARE ON ITS ENTIRE RIGHT-OF-WAY, BETWEEN CATHCART STREET AND SHERBROOKE STREET. IT WILL DEPLOY ABUNDANT VEGETATION THAT IS PART OF THE EMBLEMATIC LANDSCAPE OF MCGILL COLLEGE AVENUE AND ENHANCE THE SPIRIT OF THE PLACE, BY TAKING INTO ACCOUNT THE HISTORICAL AND HERITAGE DIMENSIONS OF MCGILL COLLEGE AVENUE AND MAINTAINING THE PRECIOUS VIEW OF MOUNT ROYAL. AT THE HEART OF THE PLAN IS A FOYER. WITH A RING OF FIRE IN THE WINTER AND A SMALL OUTDOOR STAGE WITH SEATING IN THE SUMMER, THE FOYER WILL ACT AS THE CENTREPIECE OF THE PLAZA.

WITHIN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO THE RODDICK GATES, THE PROJECT WILL IMPACT THE STUDENT EXPERIENCE ON CAMPUS. STUDENTS ARE WELCOME TO UTILIZE THE PEDESTRIAN AVENUE AS AN OUTDOOR STUDY ENVIRONMENT AND AN 'EXTENSION' OF THE MCGILL UNIVERSITY CAMPUS.

THE REVITALIZATION PROJECT WILL TAKE PLACE IN TWO LOTS:

- LOT 1: FROM CATHCART STREET TO BOULEVARD DE MAISONNEUVE W
- LOT 2: FROM BOULEVARD DE MAISONNEUVE W TO SHERBROOKE STREET
- LOT 1 DESIGN CONCEPT WAS AWARDED AND TO BE CARRIED OUT BY CIVILITI + MANDAWORKS (SWEDEN) AND SNC-LAVALIN
- LOT 2 DESIGN CONCEPT WILL FOLLOW
