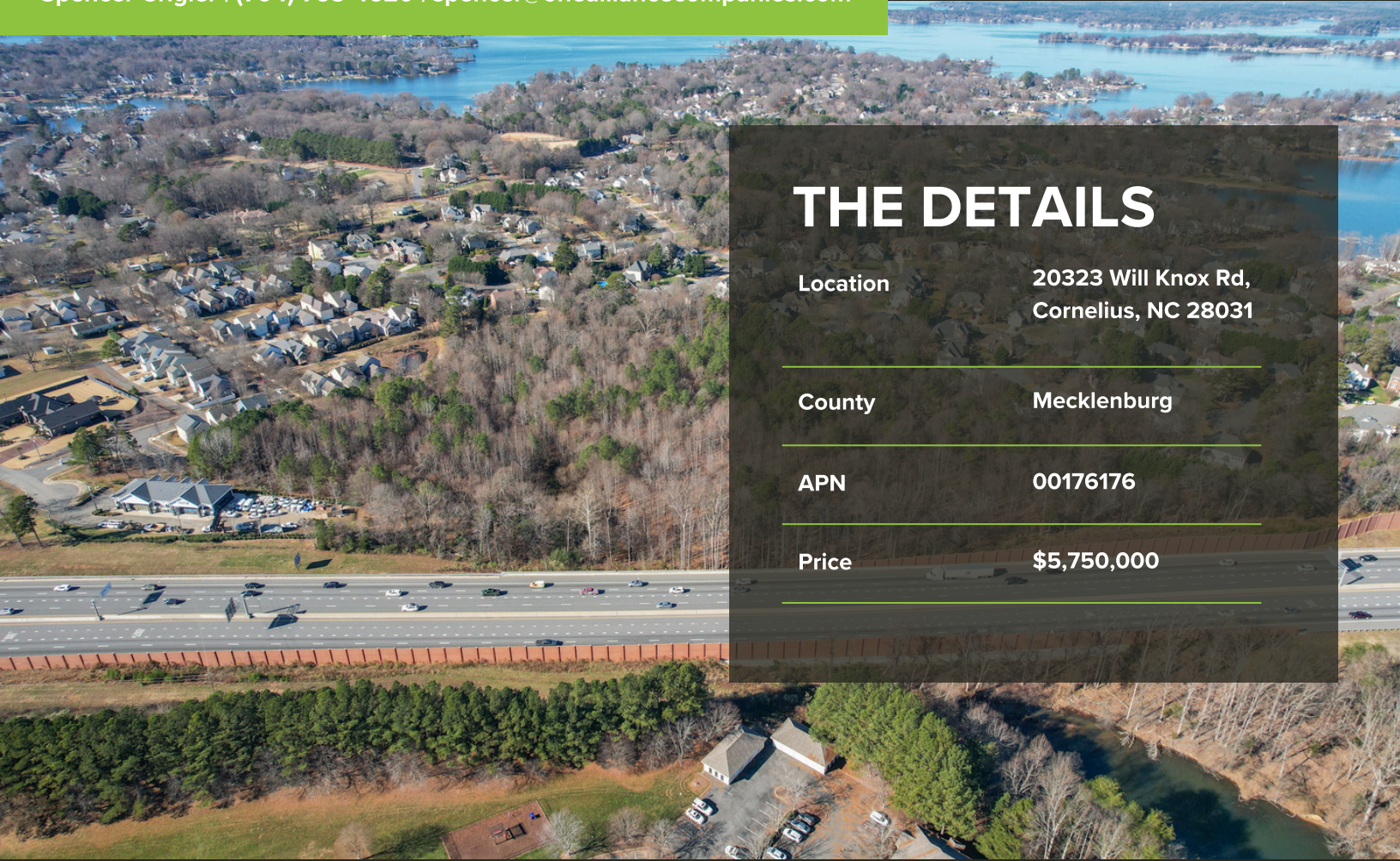

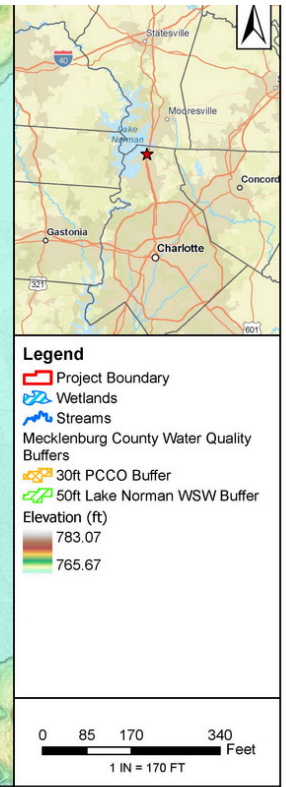
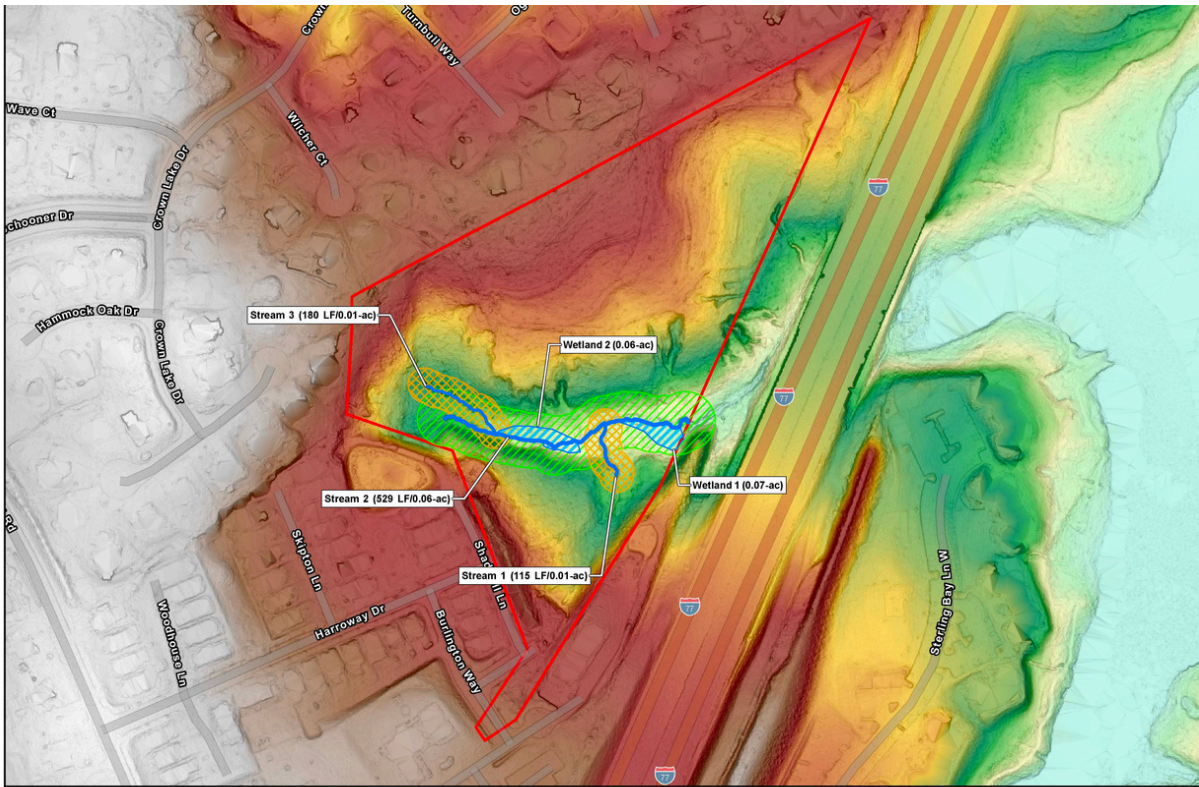


Figure 2: Aquatic Resources Delineation (LIDAR)

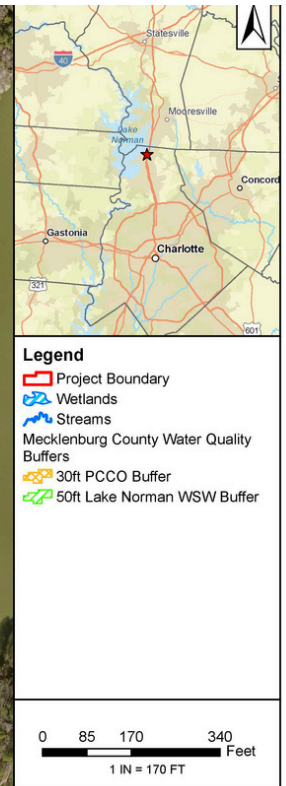
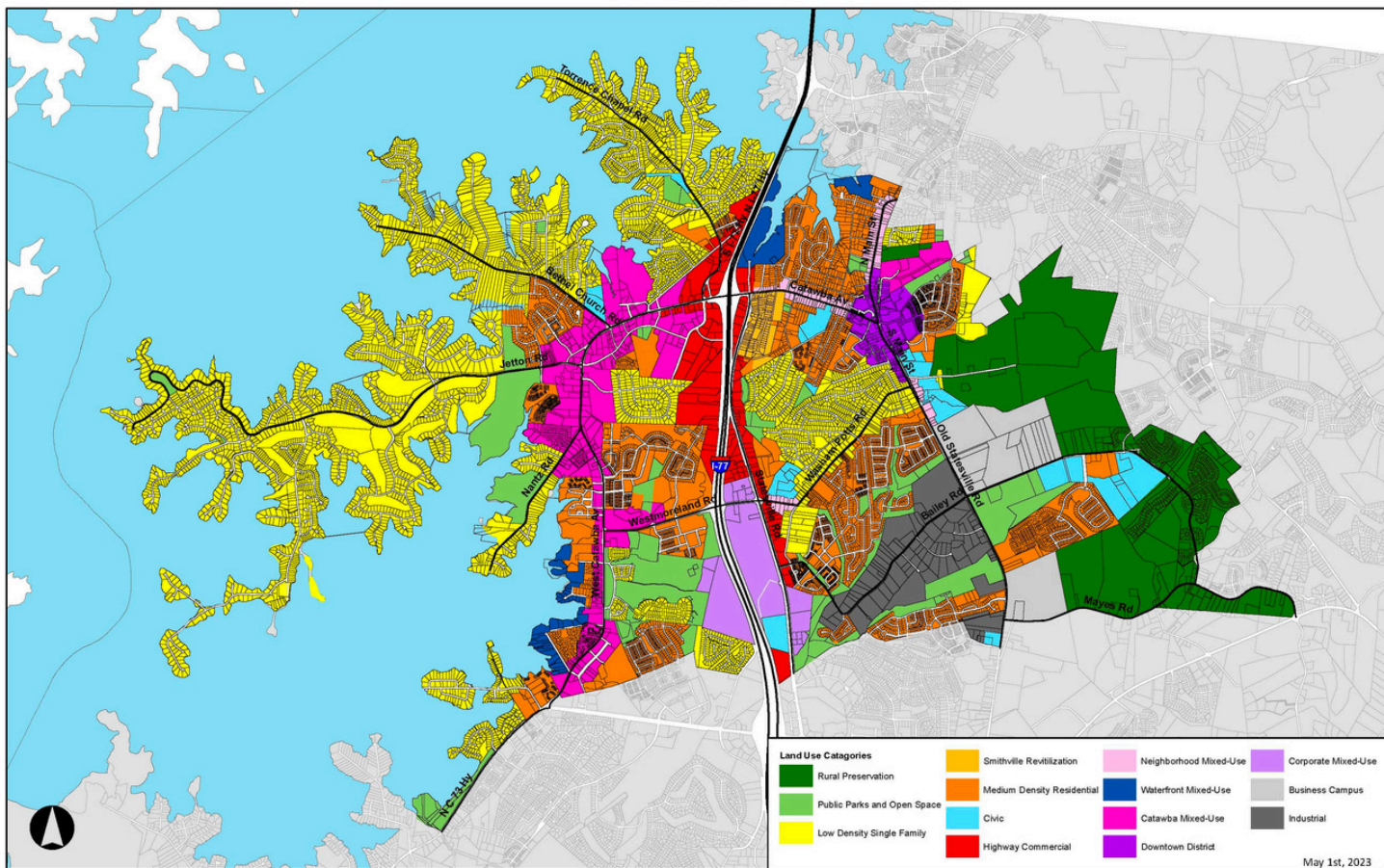
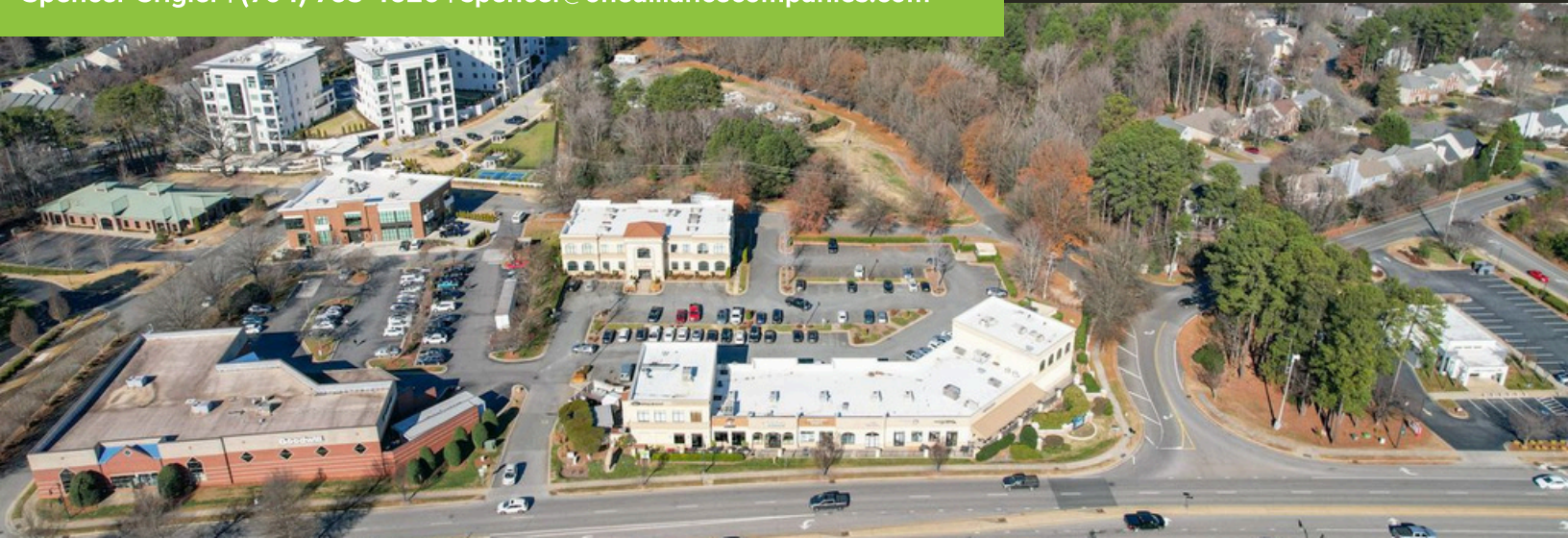


Figure 1: Aquatic Resources Delineation

ABOUT THE AREA

CORNELIUS, NC

Cornelius, North Carolina is a vibrant lakeside town located in northern Mecklenburg County, just 20 miles north of Charlotte.
