

THE LEGEND OF Clarence "Dude" DeWalt



In the early 1930's Clarence "Dude" DeWalt worked as a sheep foreman for the Highland Sheep Company. Long, hard days were routine for this line of work. One evening extracurricular activities occurred when the shepherds invited two women from town to join them for a few drinks. A fight over one of the women ensued and "Dude" was stabbed. The Gulch the winery sits on today is named after him.

Located in the rugged Eagle Foothills, outside Boise, Idaho is Dude DeWalt Cellars, built by people who work to preserve the memory and legend of this incredible area. We craft our wine to embody the same spirit of the land itself, and the pioneers who daringly came before us.
