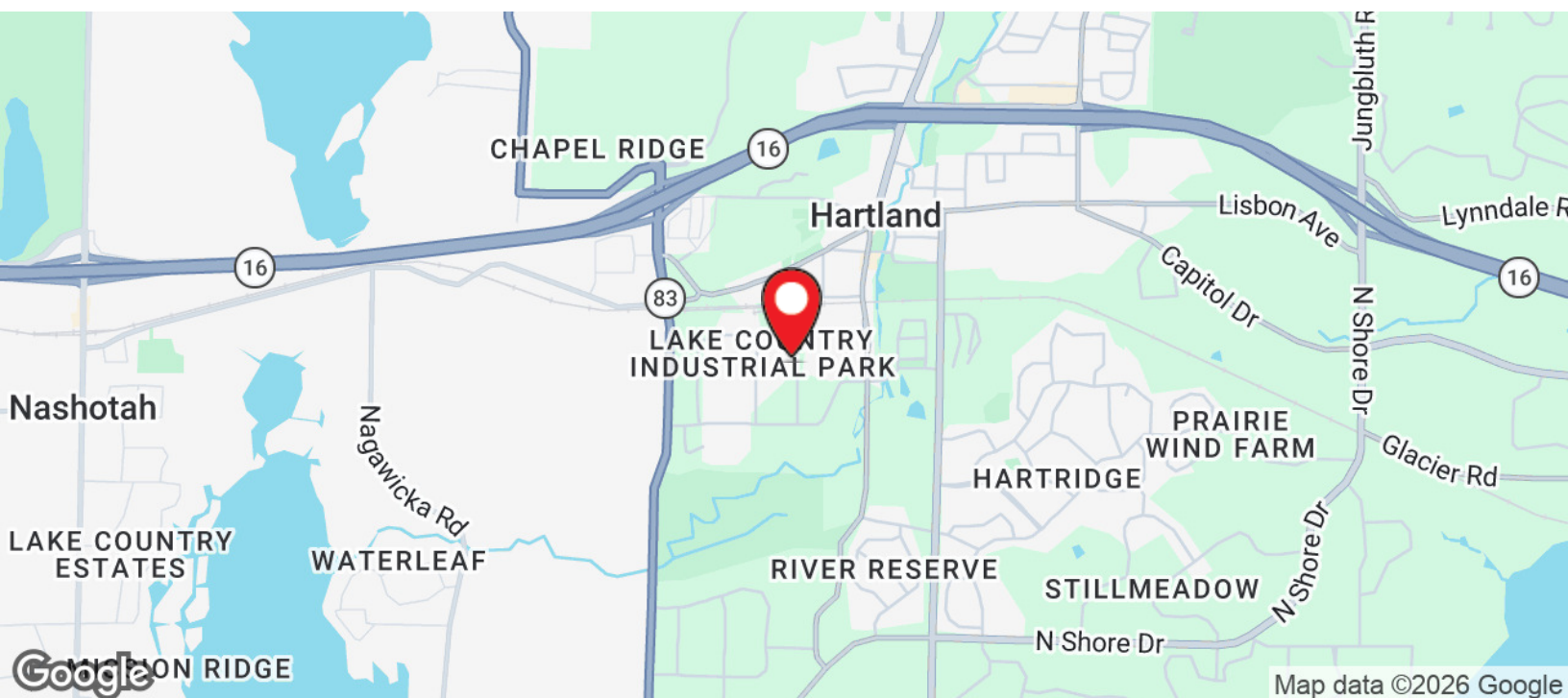

15 confidential information or the confidential information of other parties (see lines 23-41).
 - 16 (f) The duty to safeguard trust funds and other property held by the Firm or its Agents.
 - 17 (g) The duty, when negotiating, to present contract proposals in an objective and unbiased manner and disclose the
18 advantages and disadvantages of the proposals.
