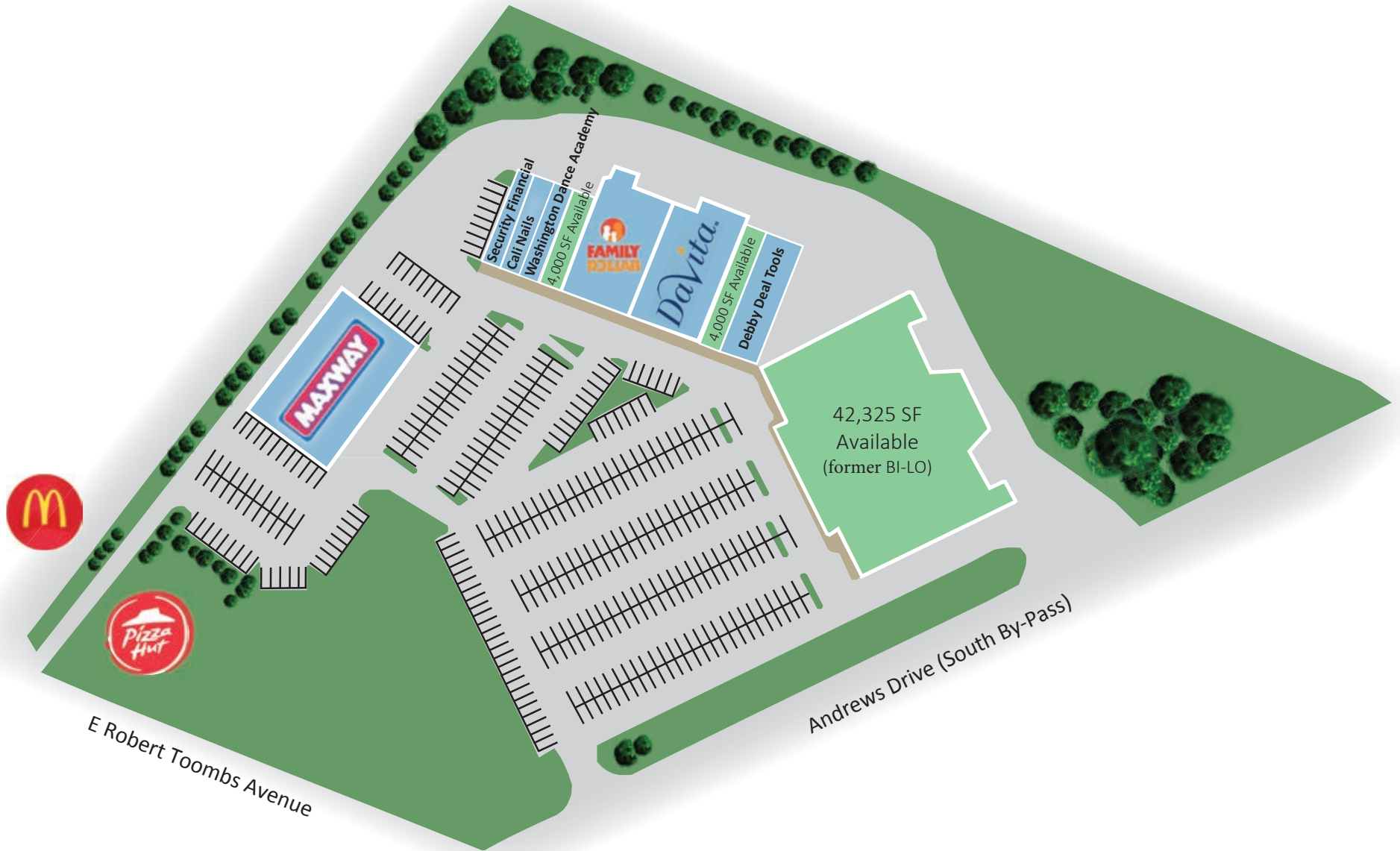




Washington Plaza is a 93,842 square-foot shopping center located at the intersection of E. Robert Toombs Avenue and Andrews Drive in Washington, Georgia. The city is located 45 miles southeast of Athens and 55 miles northwest of Augusta. Washington Plaza is the largest and most dominant retail center in the community, with customers driving up to 30 minutes in this trade area. The site is currently anchored by a BI-LO grocery store, scheduled to finish its lease at the end of May 2021. With BI-LO being one of only two major grocery stores located in the area, its exit will lead to an excellent opportunity for another grocer to lease 42,325 SF of future available space. Other available vacancies include two 4,000 SF in-line spaces, and all spaces are subdividable. Current tenants include Maxway, Family Dollar, DaVita Dialysis, Debby Deal Tools, Washington Dance Academy, Security Finance, and Cali Nails.

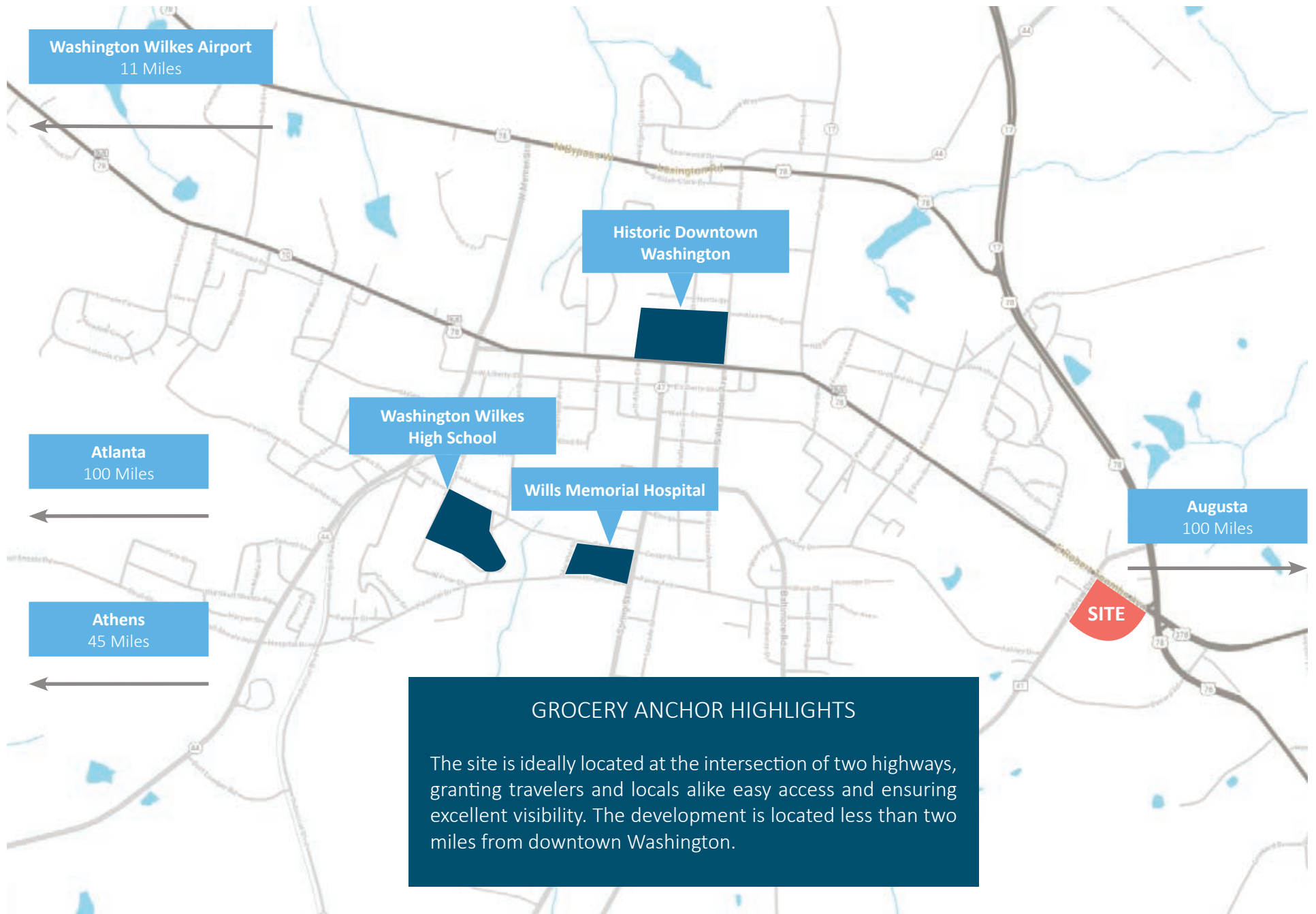
