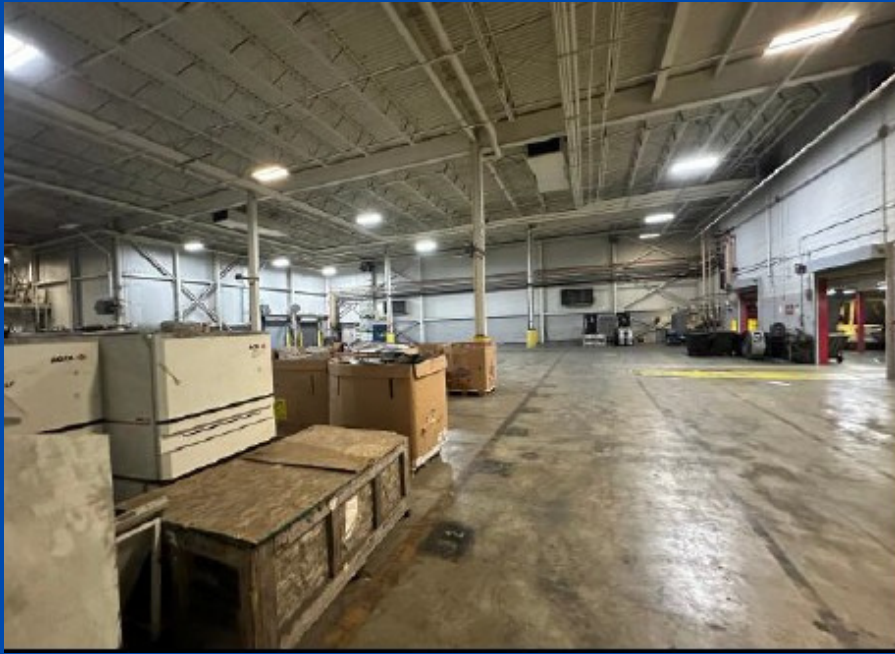

Building has been emptied of equipment and ready for an easy move in. Purpose-built for heavy industrial use, the facility features robust power capacity, 10+ dock-high and overhead doors, and variable ceiling heights of 16', 30', and 50', which will support a wide range of manufacturing, distribution, and specialty industrial operations.



Originally constructed in 1954 and significantly renovated in 1988, the building is positioned within the IR – Industrial Restricted Zone, providing favorable zoning flexibility for industrial users. The property also includes 200+ surface parking spaces and benefits from direct access to Cuthbert Blvd and Hampton Road, ensuring efficient transportation flow for employees, logistics, and freight.
