Vertical Horizons Treehouse Paradise

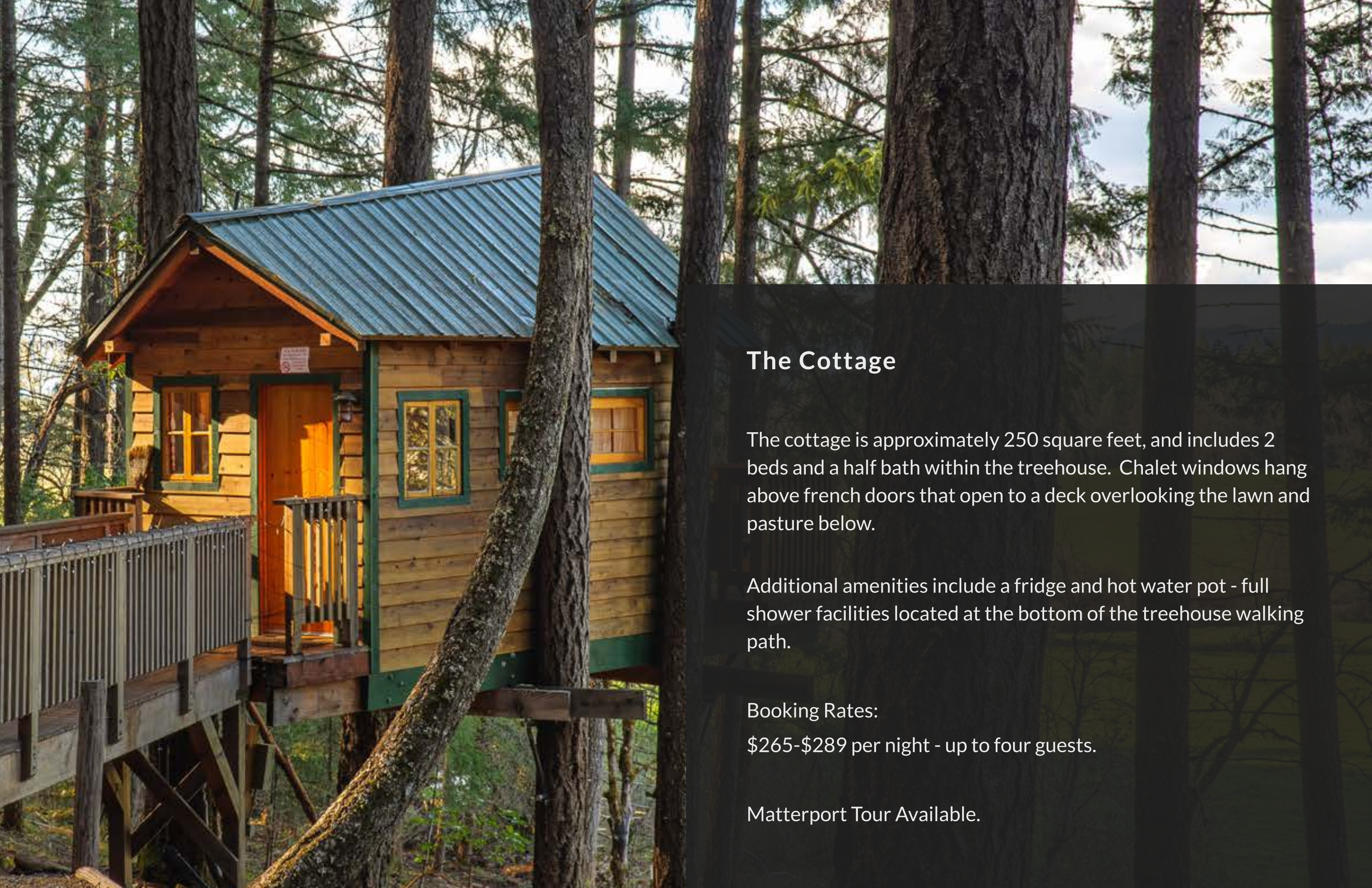
For nearly 25 years, Vertical Horizons Treehouse Paradise has been a destination for those seeking an escape from the rat race. Located in the naturally impressive Illinois Valley, VHTP is well located for adventure. Whether you'll be taking advantage of the local recreational opportunities such as Lake Selmac, the National Caves Monument, or if its just a stop on your way to the Oregon Coast - this stay is sure to please.

Four cozy and unique treehouses are tucked among the evergreens overlooking the mature hobby farm below. Bass fishing, disc golf, trail hiking, or hosting events are some of what can be enjoyed here on the property.

Just under 23 acres includes multiple ponds, green pastures for animals, a large greenhouse for growing to your hearts content, plus all of the expected amenities of rural living.

The Illinois Valley enjoys immense natural beauty as well as a varied climate. Locals enjoy all four seasons - the Illinois River offers relief from a hot summer and you can expect some beautiful white snow in the winter; while fall and spring provide enchantingly mild weather perfect for outdoor recreation!





The Cottage

Calypso

Calypso is approximately 150 square feet, and includes 1 queen bed and a half bath within the treehouse. The live tree within the living space provides natural charm and the eating nook overlooks the property below.

The Excalifir

The Shiitake

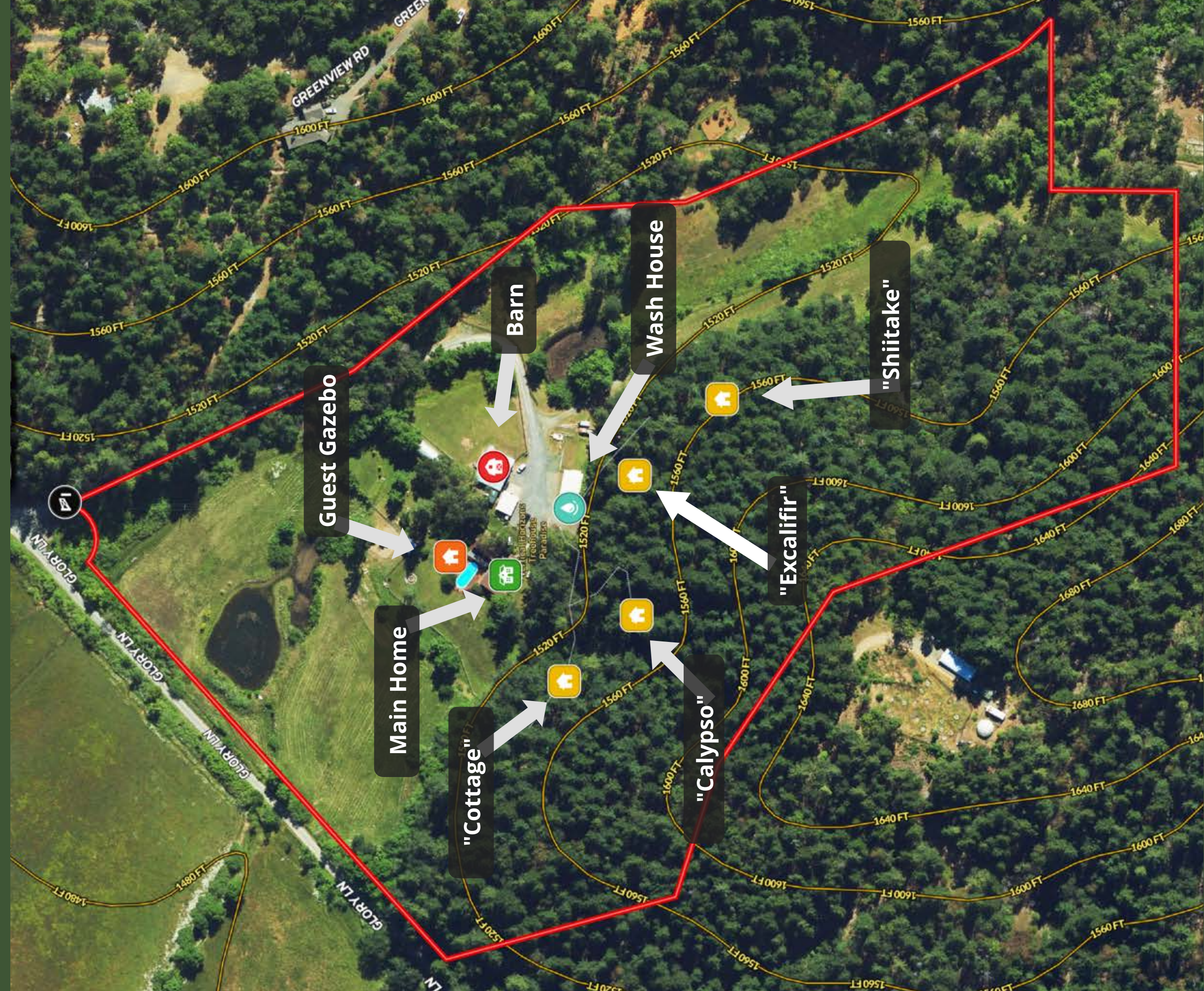
