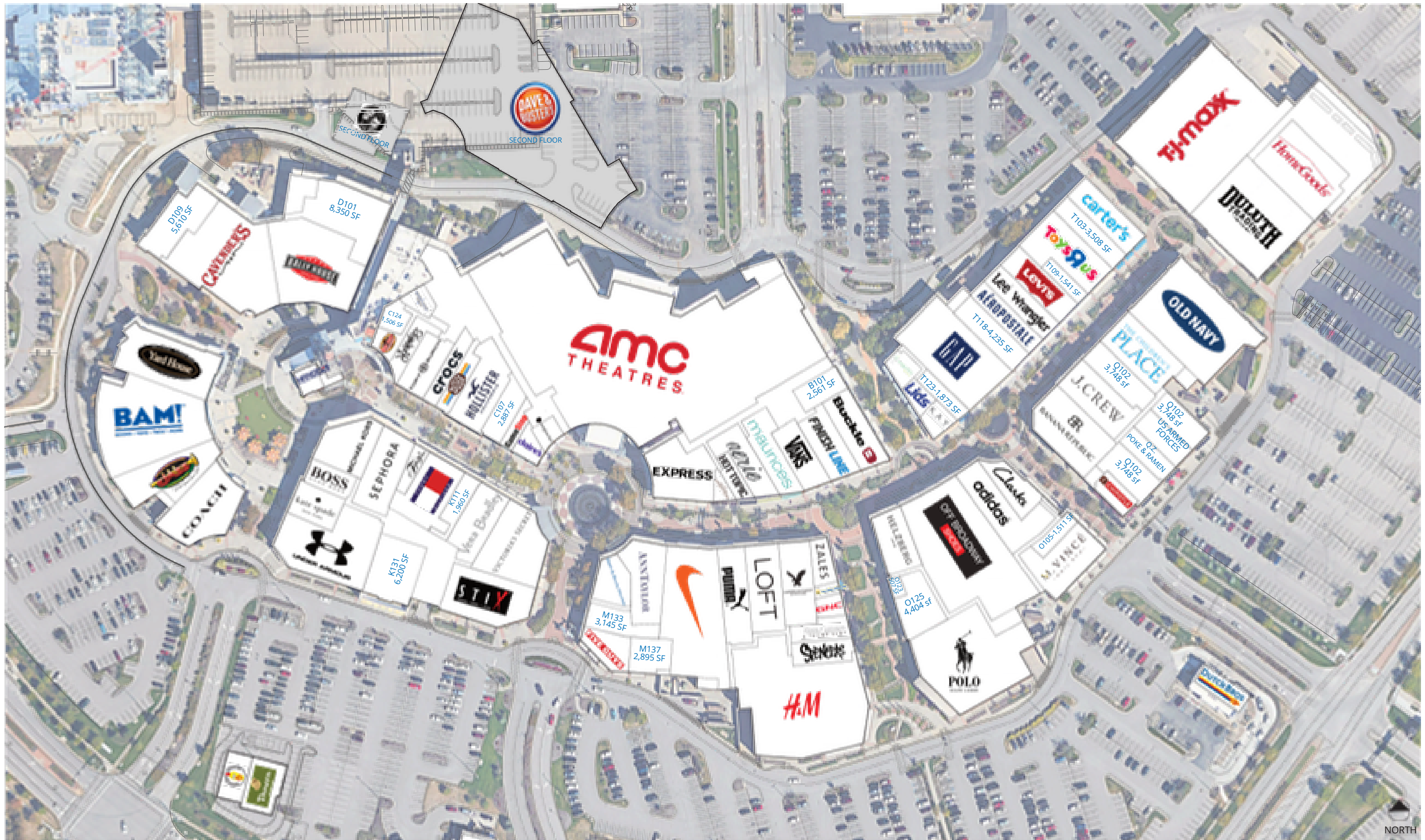

Kansas Speedway & Hollywood Casino: Premier NASCAR venue (50K capacity) / Casino \$166M in annual gaming revenue (2024, +4.0% YoY)

Legends Field (MiLB): 5K seating with 20K capacity for concerts and special events

Great Wolf Lodge: 38K SF indoor water park; 281 resort rooms

Sporting KC (MLS) stadium: 18.5K capacity for major league soccer and 25K for concerts – 2026 FIFA World Cup Host Venue

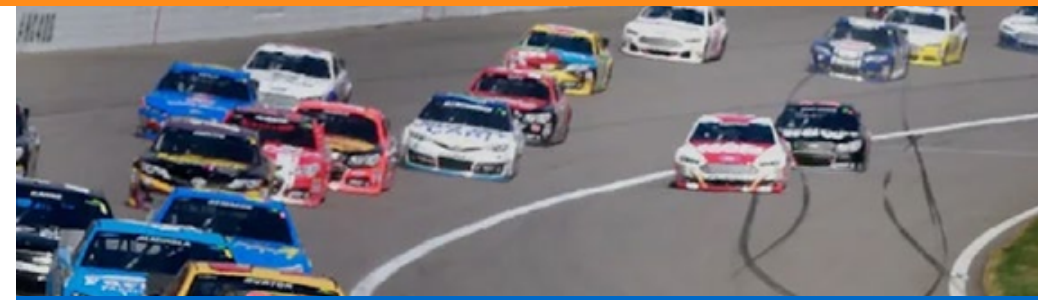

- New Mattel Adventure Park (infrastructure construction starting in 2026, with vertical construction by 2027, and completion no later than 2030) [article](#)
- Buc-ee's: 74K SF Proposed for 2027 on I-70 & 110th St. just south of Kansas Speedway: 120 gas pumps, 12 electric vehicle charging stations

American Royal – Under Construction (open 2026 – 2027) [website](#)

- New \$375M state of the art agriculture showcase and learning and discovery campus
- American Royal's campus features a 390k sf livestock barn/exhibition hall, a pair of indoor arenas and a 75k sf outdoor arena. An 80k sf Agricultural Education Center with 150k sf of additional exhibit and outdoor learning space.
- The American Royal also has the option to develop a 120-acre festival area with a concert lawn as part of a future second phase. If it builds the festival grounds, the total cost would increase to \$450 million.

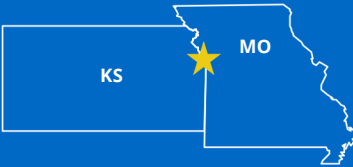

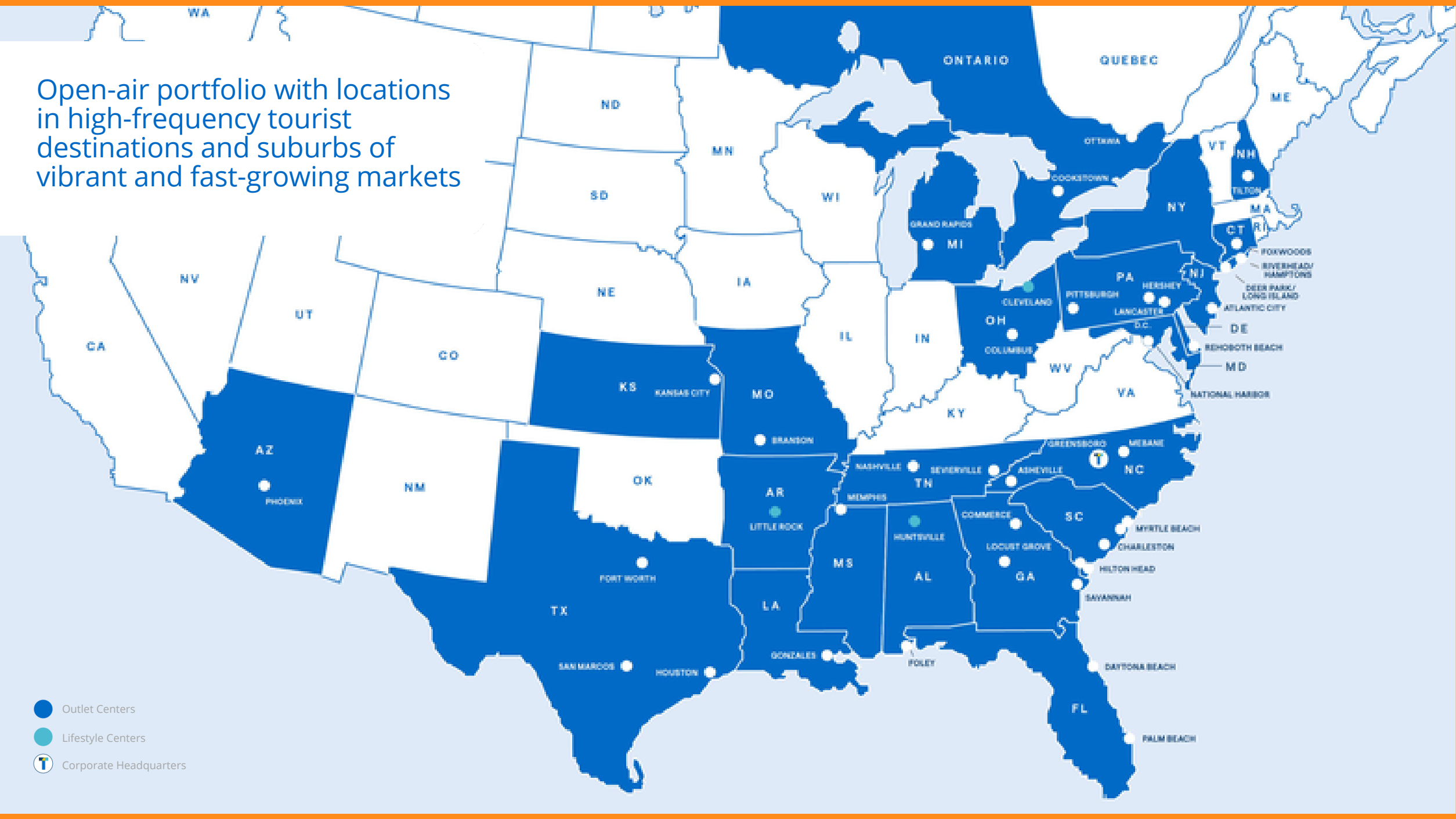
