The first floor is designed to support a variety of professional office users, featuring a welcoming reception area with space for a front desk and guest seating. The floor plan includes three private offices, three additional offices or support workspaces, and a centrally located open area well-suited for collaborative work, meetings, or team functions. The first floor also features high ceilings.

The second floor provides additional flexibility with two spacious rooms, each featuring 7'4" ceiling heights, making them ideal for private offices, conference rooms, storage, or specialized workspace needs. This level also includes a kitchenette and a common lobby area that can serve as a waiting area, informal meeting space, or employee lounge.

For convenience, half bathrooms are located on both floors.

"RALEIGH WAS FOUNDED IN 1792 AS N.C.'S CAPITAL CITY. IT WAS NAMED FOR SIR WALTER RALEIGH, WHO ATTEMPTED TO ESTABLISH THE FIRST ENGLISH COLONY ON THE SHORES OF THE NEW WORLD IN THE 1580'S. IT IS THE ONLY STATE CAPITAL TO HAVE BEEN PLANNED AND ESTABLISHED BY A STATE AS THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT. THE CITY'S FOUNDING FATHERS CALLED RALEIGH THE "CITY OF OAKS" AND DEDICATED THEMSELVES TO MAINTAINING THE AREA'S WOODED TRACTS AND GRASSY PARKS
